- 15 For this reason I too, having heard of the faith in the Lord Jesus which exists among you and your love for all the saints,
- 16 do not cease giving thanks for you, while making mention of you in my prayers;
- 17 that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom and of revelation in the knowledge of Him.
- 18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,

- 22 And He put all things in subjection under His feet, and gave Him as head over all things to the church, 23 which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.
