Psalm 100:3 – Know that the Lord Himself is God; It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; We are His people and the sheep of His pasture.

Psalm 24:1 – The earth is the Lord's, and all it contains, The world, and those who dwell in it.

Colossians 1:16 – For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him.

1 Kings 8:46 – When they sin against You (for there is no man who does not sin) and You are angry with them and deliver them to an enemy, so that they take them away captive to the land of the enemy, far off or near;

Proverbs 20:9 – Who can say, "I have cleansed my heart, I am pure from my sin"?

John 8:34 – Jesus answered them, "Truly, truly, I say to you, everyone who commits sin is the slave of sin."

Romans 6:17a – But thanks be to God that though you were slaves of sin...

Jeremiah 17:9 – "The heart is more deceitful than all else And is desperately sick; Who can understand it?"

Colossians 1:21 – And although you were formerly alienated and hostile in mind, engaged in evil deeds

Colossians 1:15 – He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.

John 14:9–10 – Jesus said to him, “Have I been so long with you, and yet you have not come to know Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; how can you say, ‘Show us the Father’? 10“Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father is in Me?
