
Bookstore

No matter how many times we may have read through the gospels, the words of Jesus are so striking they just seem to leap off the page. Our Lord spoke in such plain and simple language, and yet His Words changed the course of human history.

One of the most familiar examples of this truly profound speech is commonly referred to as "the Golden Rule." In Matthew 7:12 Jesus said, "So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them" (ESV). Just imagine how this one principle could affect a struggling marriage, transform a tense workplace, or defuse an angry commuter. It's important to remember that Jesus' words, though binding for every human, were directed toward His followers. It is only those who have been set free from their bondage to sin who can truly apply this principle on a consistent basis in their lives.

So with this in mind, how does the Golden Rule affect Children's Ministry at Grace Community Church? Because we understand the significance of the gospel's impact in our own lives, we desire to share that lifechanging truth with every child. And like most people, we wish to be treated with kindness, and so we seek to treat those in our care with the utmost kindness and consideration. We also enjoy it when others make a special effort to ensure that we have a good experience wherever we are; therefore we believe children should have an especially wonderful experience any time they attend Grace Church.

How might the Golden Rule influence you to serve in Children's Ministry at Grace Church? If you can look back on your life with gratitude for those who invested in you with the gospel from an early age, then maybe
