THEY WILL GLORIFY GOD FOR YOUR OBEDIENCE

For the ministry of this service is not only fully supplying the needs of the saints, but is also overflowing through many thanksgivings to God. Because of the proof given by this ministry, they will glorify God for your obedience to your confession of the gospel of Christ and for the liberality of your contribution to them and to all, while they also, by prayer on your behalf, yearn for you because of the surpassing grace of God in you.

—2 Corinthians 9:12-14

As Paul writes in 2 Corinthians 9, when the saints in Jerusalem experienced significant financial need, the Corinthian church provided a generous monetary gift—a gift that not only fully met the needs of the church in Jerusalem, but also resulted in "many thanksgivings to God." This gift was an expression of authentic faith and obedience that brought to glory to God and at the same time created a bond between believers separated by great distance.

This same generosity is manifested here at Grace Church in your overflowing support of the Lord's work—especially when it comes to our missionaries. Just like the Corinthians, our church has always been quick to fully supply the needs of the saints both here and

around the world by consistently looking for opportunities to give.

One of these opportunities happens every September, when we jointly participate in supporting the Lord's work through our missionaries. During "Christmas in September" we plan ahead to make sure that our missionaries know that even though they are far away from us during the holidays, they are certainly not forgotten. This is a wonderful reminder of our love for these faithful servants who are so far from home, and a great opportunity to experience the joy of "fully supplying the needs of the saints."
