
Bookstore

PROCLAIMING CHRIST ALONE TO THE NATIONS

Since 1992, Grace Church has sent out graduates of The Master's Seminary (TMS) as missionaries around the world with the goal of establishing pastoral training centers and seminaries. Today, these servants are scattered across many nations, strengthening the international church by training and equipping those who have been called to preach and lead.

You know many of these missionaries well. You pray for them faithfully. You support them financially. You fellowship with them when they return for furlough. But what you may not be familiar with is the ministry that undergirds their training centers by providing financial support and academic accountability. This ministry is The Master's Academy International (TMAI).

TMAI comprises seventeen training centers and seminaries around the world, all established or staffed by TMS graduates and Grace Church missionaries. With more than 1,500 current students and 4,000 graduates, these schools all share a common doctrinal statement (the same one that we have here at Grace Church) and a common goal—to help the indigenous church train its own pastors and leaders in biblical integrity. With an emphasis on expository preaching, these nationals are trained to biblically shepherd Christ's church and entrust their ministries to the next generation of faithful men (2 Timothy 2:2). This results in stronger indigenous churches that are able to reach their communities far better than missionaries could.

In addition to supporting our training centers, another important role that TMAI plays is to equip national church leaders as well as American missions pastors with biblical teaching on important issues and trends in missions. Today, one such issue concerns the true person and work of Jesus Christ. Around the world, there is incredible pressure to compromise the uniqueness and exclusivity of the gospel of Jesus Christ. In Asia and Latin America. the prosperity gospel is permeating the churches. In Africa, religious syncretism has long prevailed on the continent. In Roman Catholic contexts, a system of works-based righteousness continues to hold sway. And in Europe and North America, ecumenism and liberalism are confusing and wreaking havoc on the church. To reach these lands with the transforming power of the gospel, a proper view of Christ is essential.

To address this vital issue, TMAI is pleased to host a one-day event in coordination with the 2017 Shepherds' Conference Summit on Christology. At the TMAI International Symposium, the doctrine of Christology will be examined from an international perspective by trusted church leaders from around the world. Speakers from Africa, Asia, Europe, South America, and the Middle East will make it clear why the proclamation of Christ alone is critical not just in America, but also to overseas missions efforts and ministries.

Currently, attendees from thirty-four different nations are registered for the Symposium. Grace Church members are invited to join us for this important day. Please pray with us that this event will contribute to a renewal movement in evangelical missions.
