Over the last seven years, we have revitalized the second-oldest building on campus (the Heritage Building), enhanced GraceWalk, and transformed a storage room into Steeple House Coffee. We re-invented Grace Grill, and remodeled our beloved Fireside Room while preserving its legacy as the "Grace Church living room." The renovation of the Family Center has allowed us to upgrade and expand the use of the gym from a place only for athletic events to a venue for weddings, conferences, Sundays in July classes, and Children's Ministry events.

Through your generous gifts, we not only improved our campus but supported the growth of ministry both here at home and around the globe. Our fast-growing men's fellowship


was re-launched as "Men of the Word," while our women's ministries continues to thrive, with hundreds of women gathering each week to study Scripture and enjoy fellowship together. Last June we reached our community through Vacation Bible School, which ministered to more than 600 children. Under the umbrella of Local Outreach, our church hosts Bible studies in eight languages. And God has not only used our church family to make an impact on our community, but on the rest of the world as well. In 2011 we launched Grace Advance, which now includes twenty-five churches across the United States plus two in Canada. And in the last seven years, we deployed forty-three new missionary families to twenty-four countries.

As we look to the future and as our ministry continues to expand, there is more remodeling to be done. The Children's Center will be completed this year, and the book store and Tower Building will be the next projects that support the ongoing ministry of our church.

Thank you for your faithfulness, both in the ministry that goes on at Grace Church, and in the sacrificial support that makes it possible! ■


