THE MASTER'S SEMINARY THIRTY YEARS OF PREACHING CHRIST

Five hundred years ago, through the preaching of God's Word, the truth of the gospel shattered the unbiblical traditions of medieval Catholicism. Confronted by Scripture, hearts and minds were transformed and history was forever altered by the resulting revival. We call that revival the Reformation.

The Reformation was led by men passionately committed to the gospel of Christ as revealed in God's inerrant and infallible Word. Many of these men paid a bitter cost for their commitment to the truth, giving up physical and financial security, and often their lives, to see Christ proclaimed.

This past week, The Master's Seminary (TMS) celebrated the 500th anniversary of the Reformation alongside Grace Community Church and several thousand church leaders from around the world. At this Summit on Christology, the gospel of Christ was put on display much as it was 500 years ago.

Today the global church stands in need of further Reformation. False teaching abounds, and the pressure to conform to the world is fierce. And just as it did in the sixteenth century, reformation today must come from a renewed emphasis on preaching Christ and Christ's Word.


By God's grace, TMS is uniquely positioned to influence the world for Christ. For the last thirty years, the seminary has been actively training the next generation of faithful men to preach the Word, in season and out of season (2 Timothy 4:2). Since its establishment in 1986, the seminary has trained some 1,500 graduates to handle the Word of Christ accurately and faithfully. More than ninety percent of our graduates serve in churches across the United States and 30 foreign countries, and many have established training centers to equip nationals to serve as faithful pastors and leaders in the local church. Together, the seminary and training

centers have had the privilege of training 5,000 pastors worldwide. This privilege manifests itself each year at Shepherds' Conference, as TMS graduates return to their former place of study, bringing with them their own pastors-in-training.

The challenge Paul gave to Timothy was to handle the Word of God faithfully and accurately. For the last thirty years, our vision has been to train men to do just that. Our graduates share the same convictions that fueled that seismic movement of reformation five centuries ago. Foundational doctrines like the authority of Scripture and the purity of the gospel form the core of our curriculum. Those truths were worth contending for in the sixteenth century, and still are today.
