During a work-related trip to South Africa, the Lord used TMS graduate Tim Cantrell to affirm Faly's desire for full-time ministry, and God subsequently opened the door for pastoral training at The Master's Seminary.

Faly, his wife, Lily, and their five children are now preparing to return to Madagascar to identify, train, and equip Malagasy pastors. His ultimate goal is to establish a seminary and train the next generation of godly church leaders who will impact many souls for the cause of the gospel of Jesus.
