

Tourists to Italy have a lot of fun with the Leaning Tower of Pisa. This famous, 183-foot structure leans at a four-degree angle, which horizontally displaces the top about 13 feet from the center. The Leaning Tower draws massive crowds year-round who stand in the foreground and take pictures of themselves pretending to push the tower down, hold the tower up, and everything in between.

Construction of the tower began in August 1173, and by the time the third story was built it already had a noticeable lean. Unsurprisingly, the frantic architects and engineers found that one side of the structure was built on a foundation too soft to support the weight of the marble building blocks. However, construction continued, and today the tower stands eight stories high. And while it makes for a fine tourist attraction, it is hard to imagine productive work getting accomplished in a building where your cup of coffee slides off the table.

The lesson to learn from the Leaning Tower of Pisa is obvious it is crucial for a building to have a solid foundation. You don't need to be a structural engineer to know that if the foundation is unstable. the whole building is compromised. Scripture often speaks of the church using metaphors of buildings and foundations. Perhaps most famously, Jesus said, "I will build My church" (Matthew 16:18). Paul later wrote that the church is "built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Christ Jesus Himself being the cornerstone" (Ephesians 2:20). The cornerstone was the first stone laid in the foundation of a building and the most important; it had to be cut and laid with precision because every other part of the building was oriented to it. The walls, doors, floor, and ceiling would all be built in reference to the cornerstone. The cornerstone kept the building straight and true. Paul says this most important stone in the church is Jesus Christ Himself, whose life, teaching, cross, and kingship define the church's very existence.

With Jesus as the cornerstone and the ministry and teaching of the prophets and apostles as the rest of the foundation, the church is built on the most solid foundation. But there's more. When Jesus said, "I will build My church," He took up the job of building the church Himself. He is ultimately responsible for the building of the church—that is, sinners being saved and saints growing in their faith—and this endeavor cannot fail, because this builder is omnipotent and sovereign.

It is this profound truth that drives this year's Shepherds' Conference: that Jesus is sovereignly building His church on the rock-solid foundation of Himself. The pastors and church leaders who attend the conference will be comforted and emboldened with this truth. We hope you'll take the opportunity this March to encourage our guests in their ministry of being used by Christ to build His church.
