

The very first Shepherds' Conference was held in 1980 with the goal of equipping pastors and church leaders to shepherd the people in their churches more biblically and effectively. Over the years, the conference has focused on a wide variety of topics including biblical inerrancy, spiritual growth, and preaching Christ. This year's theme, "I Will Build My Church," captures the heart of the conference, and serves as a reminder of why Shepherds' Conference was started nearly four decades ago.

For three days, pastors and church leaders will hear sermons and lectures on the church itself. They will be encouraged by hearing how the sovereign Lord of the universe is building His church, and they will be reminded of what a great privilege and responsibility it is to be used by Him to lead His people. Every element of this conference will push these men to shepherd their churches more faithfully, lead more boldly, teach more effectively, and love more deeply. They will be freshly amazed by the truth that they are

stewards entrusted with shepherding the church of Christ—the church so precious to Him that He purchased her with His own blood (Acts 20:28).


More than 850 volunteers and staff members from our church are eager and ready to serve these men. They are excited to model the kind of church being considered at the conference—the body of Christ marked by unity and the family of God marked by love and service. Thank you, to those of you who have sacrificed your time and even taken time off work to serve this year!

We are also grateful for those of you who support the conference through your prayers, which is perhaps the most important responsibility, and one in which everyone can participate. To that end, there is a table on the patio this morning where you can pick up a card with the names of five men attending the conference. Our goal is to pray for all of the attendees by name, asking the Lord to

bless their time at the conference, and praying that the Word would produce a fruitful harvest in the hearts and lives of these men.

We also invite you to view the conference sessions via livestream at shepherdsconference.org. Please note that in order to best accommodate and serve our 3,200 attendees, the campus will be closed to non-attendees throughout the week (except for the last session on Friday, March 9, at 7:00 p.m.). For this session, we invite you to watch Pastor John's closing sermon and enjoy fellowship with the attendees in the Family Center.

We pray that God will use this year's conference to strengthen these church leaders so that His work of building His church will continue. "To Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen" (Ephesians 3:21).
