What is a theologian?

The term can conjure images of elite educators and the hallowed halls of academia. It's a name often applied to learned men of letters—those who spend their lives in libraries, publishing great tomes on doctrinal fine points. Within the church, there is a tendency to see theologians as separate and elevated—the all-stars of the Body of Christ. They're the Christian upper-class who publish articles, write books, teach in seminaries, and frequent the lecture circuit.

But while many of those things are common to those who travel in theological circles, none of them make someone a theologian.

Instead, the distinguishing characteristic of theologians is that they know God, and pursue a deeper knowledge of Him and His Word. In spite of how we often use the term *theologian*, it is not a profession, but a way of life—and one that should be common to everyone who claims to believe in Christ.

In John's gospel, the Lord Himself said, "This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and

Jesus Christ whom You have sent" (John 17:3). That is not an optional endeavor; it's a mandate for the church. If Christ has called you to repentance and faith, He has called you to be a theologian.

And that's not a calling anyone can fulfill by merely sitting in a pew for an hour or two every week. True theologians are not content to be spoon fed their doctrine—they actively seek out the rich meat of God's Word. They understand the practical value of their theology, and how it touches all aspects of their everyday lives—their work, their families, and their usefulness to God's kingdom.

However, none of us have been called to do it alone. God has given His people the Body of Christ to sharpen and train one another. It would be foolish—and even dangerous—to assume any of us could become sound theologians in a vacuum. Left to our own devices, we would struggle to develop biblical hermeneutics, orthodox theology, and practical doctrine that leads to spiritual growth and personal holiness.

To address those needs and help God's people attain to this lofty calling, The Master's Seminary is proud to announce The Institute for Church Leadership. The Institute is designed to bring all the vital areas of Bible training, theological instruction, and practical ministry into the pew. We want to make these indispensable tools accessible to laymen at all levels of church leadership and spiritual maturity. This program will be an aid to new believers as well as seasoned saints.
