A DEEPER NEED

As Christians, we believe that God left believers on earth so that others would come to know Christ by seeing Him in us. Think about it: every good part of Christian life would be made perfect if God took us out of the world. We would worship Him more perfectly in heaven. We would have closer, purer fellowship with other Christians in heaven. But Jesus left us on earth with the responsibility to love others—other flawed, sinful humans—as He loved us, "so that by all means [we] might save some" (1 Corinthians 9:22).

We have a great opportunity to extend this love every week at Grace Church. Every Tuesday, 80–100 people with special needs come to our campus for an evening of games, singing, and teaching from God's

Word. We try to make it a fun, welcoming environment where these folks (and the wonderful caregivers who bring them) can build relationships with people in our church family. We have gym time, games, teaching, prayer, music, and a memory verse that all tie in with one central theme for the year. Last year, our theme was "Loving God," and we memorized Matthew 22:37: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind."

Physical activity is a state requirement for our special needs friends who live in group homes. With Grace Club, we have the opportunity to meet a practical need while also addressing a spiritual one. We get to provide a picture of hospitality by opening our campus, and we get to show love actively in every conversation, casual or intimate, that we have with our Grace Club guests.

Many of the people who visit our campus for Grace Club don't go to our church—a few do, but most of them are from the community. For many of the disabled folks and their caregivers, this is the only gospel presentation they'll hear in any given week, and many of them hear the gospel preached clearly for the very first time in Grace Club. It's a blessing to see how God has developed some great relationships—not only with the kids, but between us and the caregivers—in a context where the love of Christ is always the central focus.

SPECIAL MINISTRIES

There are two ways you can get involved in evangelism through Special Ministries: you can pray that God will continue to bring people to this ministry, and that He would draw these folks to Himself through the preaching of His Word; and you can join us on a Tuesday evening and get to know our disabled friends and their caregivers. Take this opportunity to remember the love you know in Christ, and join us as we seek to show His love to those who need nothing so much as eternal life in Him.
