And he sat down and called the twelve. And he said to them, "If anyone would be first, he must be last of all and servant of all." —Mark 9:35

In our society today, everyone wants to be first. We see this daily in social media. Most of social media is about promoting self. People want the accolades of other people as they strive to be known. However, this was not the heart of our Savior. He came not to be served, but to serve others and ultimately lay down His life (Mark 10:45). Jesus tells His disciples that if anyone wants to be first, they must be last and be a servant of all. This truth ought to encourage our hearts to be like our Savior and serve the way He did.

One of the ways you can do that at Grace Church is by serving in Children's Ministry. Every week, there is an opportunity to serve the body of Christ by serving the children. Our children are important to us just like they were important to Christ (Mark 9:36–37). Those who serve in Children's Ministry are an example of Christ to the children. They serve with humility and

Sunday evenings also offer opportunities to serve in Adventure Club and help children memorize and apply God's Word in their lives.

Whether on Sunday morning, Sunday evening, or in the nursery, there is an opportunity for you in Children's Ministry. We invite you to come by one of the Children's Ministry tables on the patio this morning to find how you can get plugged in. We would love to talk to you about how you can serve and make an investment in children for eternity.


