PROCLAIMING THE TRUE GOSPEL

If we have an incorrect understanding of the gospel, then the rest of our faith is in vain (1 Corinthians 15:14). Doctrine informs everything we do, say, and think as we run the race, and this year's Spanish Expositors Conference (directed to Spanish-speakers living in the US and various countries) was centered around that crucial concept.

In 2016, the year we had our first conference, 600 people attended. This year, we had the privilege of ministering to more than 2,000. Beyond the

increase in numbers, the impact of this conference far exceeds the walls of our campus. Grace Church's Spanish Expositors Conference is one of the most viewed conferences on social media in the Spanish-speaking world; entire churches in Latin America gathered to watch the conference online last week, to be blessed by the preaching of the Word of God.

The keynote preachers for the conference were John MacArthur, Henry Tolopilo, Josiah Grauman,

Michael Mahoney, Paul Washer, Sugel Michelén, Evis Carballosa, and Justin Peters, among many other faithful brothers. The themes considered during the conference included the gospel and pragmatism; the correct perspective on evangelism; the gospel and the justice of God; the lie of the prosperity gospel; and the need to plant churches for the advancement of the gospel.

In addition to a time of edifying teaching and purposeful fellowship, our conference attendees were also blessed by the incredible hospitality of our church family. More than 200 volunteers served during the conference, and we know that example of faithfulness and generosity speaks volumes to the heart of our church.

From the Conference Department, thank you to everyone who supported this event—with your prayers, by providing scholarships for the attendees, and in the way you served and represented our Savior so well.

Please continue praying for the spiritual awakening that has begun in the Spanish-speaking world; that God would be glorified, and the gospel would be accurately and faithfully proclaimed.
