### **Learning to Be Content**

by John MacArthur

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."—Philippians 4:6–7

The Greek word translated "content" (autarkes) means "to be selfsufficient," "to be satisfied," "to have enough." It indicates a certain independence and lack of need for help. Paul was saving, "I have learned to be sufficient in myself—yet not in myself as myself, but as indwelt by Christ." He elsewhere expressed that subtle distinction: "I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me" (Galatians 2:20). Christ and contentment go together.

Attack anxiety in your life by applying what you have learned about contentment. Be confident in God's sovereign providence, and don't allow your circumstances to trouble you. Instead of giving in to panic, cling to the promise of Romans 8:28: "We know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God."

Regard that verse as a spiritual lifeline for the rest of your life. Also, buck the tide of our materialistic, selfish society by being satisfied with little and being more concerned about the spiritual welfare of others than your material needs. Be obedient to God's Word and confident in His power to meet all your needs. May our Lord keep all these principles in the forefront of our minds that we might be content—and free from anxiety!
