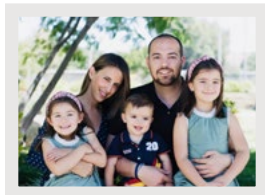

July 5-26

Sundays in July is always a wonderful encouragement for our church family, and we're especially excited for this year's opportunity to be strengthened in our spiritual lives.

The theme passage for Sundays in July 2020 is Hebrews 10:24-25—"Let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds, not forsaking our own assembling together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another; and all the more as you see the day drawing near." Our desire is to help our church family fulfill this scriptural command and transition back to campus for normal activity.

Beginning July 5, we will offer six on-campus classes during the 8:30 a.m. hour only. There will be no Nursery, Children's Ministry, or Student Ministry classes available. To make everyone comfortable, masks and hand sanitizer will be made available, and class sizes will be limited to no more than 100 attendees.

We will also live stream the main service to these rooms at 10:30 am, so attendees have the option to stay in the room for worship and enjoy the service together.
