THE PRAYER ROOM is staffed with counselors ready to offer pastoral care. It is open after every service and is adjacent to the Worship Center.



An Extraordinary GUSPEL OPPORTUNITY

STUDENT MINISTRIES

Christ's command to spread the gospel is clear: "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations" (Matthew 28:19). It compels all believers to bring the message of salvation everywhere, to all people, at all ages. It is the Great Commission that guides our youth ministry programs, which aim to make disciples among a targeted people group—teenagers.

Teenager is a word that evokes many emotions and preconceived notions in our society. Indeed, the teen years tend to be a time of unique challenge as young adults are faced with increasingly complex decisions, influences, and life lessons.

For those who are part of junior high and high school ministries, the word teenager is motivating because it represents an extraordinary opportunity

to see the gospel work mightily. Teens are eager to learn and hear new perspectives. Our goal is to help these students learn and grow in light of the reality of the saving and sanctifying power of the gospel.

There are three commitments we share as we minister the power of the gospel to the teenagers in our church:

TO PARTNER WITH PARENTS IN THEIR ONGOING GOSPEL WITNESS TO THEIR TEENAGERS. The work of student ministries is supplemental to the diligent, godly parenting that happens within our church families, and it is a joy to see the fruit of this partnership again and again (Deuteronomy 6:6–7).

TO BUILD TEENS TO BE ACTIVE CHURCH MEMBERS. A major goal

is to equip saved students to live lives committed to the church by providing opportunities to serve and live in fellowship with other believers (Hebrews 10:25).

TO EQUIP TEENS TO BE EFFECTIVE WITNESSES. It's a tremendous encouragement to see students seeking to obey the Great Commission by inviting friends to church events and camps, participating in local outreach, and actively ministering to unsaved friends on their athletic teams and campuses (Matthew 28:19–20).

As we embark upon a busy season of student ministry, please pray for the upcoming activities, summer camps, small group sessions, and outreach events all designed to make the gospel known and embraced by teenagers.

Please also pray for our faithful and godly volunteer staff who regularly give of their time and resources to make an impact on these students through teaching, training, and discipleship.

The next time you hear the word *teenager*, we hope it's a reminder to pray for the young people in your households, on our campus, and in our community. It is a thrill to see the gospel alive and working in so many hearts as Christ continues to build His church.

Stand Firm: A Study in 1 Peter

Christians are not at home in this world. That is only becoming more obvious as our culture grows increasingly hostile to Christianity. As our freedoms continue to be threatened, we are starkly reminded that we are "aliens and strangers" in a foreign land. While this may be new territory for us, it was normal for the first Christians to face rejection and tribulation from the world around them. Peter wrote his first letter to Roman Christians on the run for their lives, teaching them how to stand firm in the face of hostility—both from their rulers and even their neighbors. As we face increasing opposition from our world, we need to be reminded of these lessons as well.
