ヨハネの福音書3:31–36

Questions for Application:

- (1) What are ways we, in practice, forget that Jesus is the divine Son of God from heaven and are like John's disciples, not recognizing the superior role Jesus has over every other person? (on Jesus' being from heaven, consider Ps 115:3).
- (2) What does knowing that Jesus has greater words than anyone else and that His words are perfectly true mean for how we respond to the many different voices in the world?
- (3) What does the role of Jesus' words as testimony to Himself in the Gospel of John imply about our evangelism?
- (4) How does understanding Jesus' greater authority and what Jesus did to receive all things from the Father relate to our obedience to Him? To the assurance of our salvation? To our response to claims of other ways of salvation?
- (5) What are some practical implications of the relationship of Isaiah 55:6–7 to 8–9 (consider Mt 6:14–15; Eph 4:32; Ezek 18:23–32)?
