Week 13

When studying the Bible, remember to pray first, then ask yourself the following questions about the passage.

- *What is the point the passage is making?*
- *What does this say about God?*
- *How should I apply this in my life?*

Monday – Ephesians 3

What is the “mystery” of verses 1–6?

What was Paul’s particular ministry? (vv. 7–9)

What does it mean to have Christ “dwell in your heart”? (vv. 17–19)

Tuesday – Ephesians 4

According to verses 11–12, what is the role of a Shepherd or Teacher?

How does Paul describe the Christian life in verses 17–24?

For each sin in verses 25–32, what is the respective righteous thing that a person ought to do instead?

Wednesday – Ephesians 5

For each sin in verses 3–21, what are the righteous things a Christian ought to do instead?

What is the purpose of marriage, according to verses 22–33?

What is the wife's responsibility to her husband and a husband's responsibility to his wife? (vv. 22–33)

Thursday – Ephesians 6

What is the reason a child must obey their parents? (vv. 1–4)

How should a Christian view their responsibilities? (vv. 5–9)

How should a Christian respond to Satan's schemes? (vv. 10–20)

Friday – Jude

Describe the false teachers that Jude was confronting.

What is Jude quoting in verses 14–15?

How should Christians respond to these false teachers? (vv. 20–23)
