3. Interpretation

1. Examine the relationship between line 1 and line 2.

Generally:

Line 2 is synonymous with line 1 (reiterates)

Line 2 is antithetical to line 1 (contrasts)

Line 2 is synthetic with line 1 (expands)

These relationships are fairly straightforward. Aim to press into them and consider more specifically the relationship.
