



Preventative Teeth Cleaning

Your pet will be undergoing a preventative teeth cleaning procedure. The procedure includes the following.

- Assessment: an oral cavity palpation and probing tooth by tooth
- Charting: noting visible abnormalities or concerns
- Cleaning: scaling and curettage
- Polishing: smoothing out minor defects
- Brush & flush: rinsing and removing excess debris

A technician from Pet Dental Services, that is specially trained, will perform the procedure. Your pet will NOT have dental radiographs taken during this procedure. This procedure is done with your pet awake. Mild sedation can be used if the patient is anxious but cooperative. If your pet is found to have any significant dental disease during the procedure such as, pocketing, furcations or fractures, the procedure will be stopped with no charge incurred and an estimate for a dental performed under anesthesia will be provided. During this procedure the airway is not protected and, though the risk is small, there is always a chance the patient could aspirate.
