



Live, play, study in a **SAFE HOME!**

- ✓ **HAVE A FAMILY PLAN** in case of fire, earthquake, blackout, flood or any other emergency.
- ✓ **PREPARE** an emergency kit and agree to a family meeting place.
- ✓ **KNOW** and **PRACTICE** escape routes.
- ✓ **KEEP** toys, school supplies, clothes and shoes stored if you are not using them.
- ✓ **NEVER** play with or drink liquids that are in unlabeled containers, smell strange or are stored in garages or closets.
- ✓ **ALWAYS** wash your hands after playing, going to the bathroom and before eating.
- ✓ **DO NOT** eat or chew anything but food.
- ✓ **MEMORIZE** the telephone number of a person you can call if you need help. During emergencies, call 9-1-1.
- ✓ **LET AN ADULT KNOW** immediately if you notice an unusual smell or see smoke in your house or yard.
- ✓ **STAY AWAY** from the stove, oven, heaters, fireplaces and open flames.
- ✓ **NEVER** play in the kitchen or with the stove, candles, matches or lighters.
- ✓ **ASK FOR HELP** from an adult if you need to plug in a phone, light, computer, etc.
- ✓ **CRAWL LOW** under smoke and **GET OUT** of the house immediately during a fire.
- ✓ **STOP, DROP** and **ROLL**, if your clothes catch fire. Cover your face with your hands and **ROLL** until the flames are out, cool the burn with cool water and call 9-1-1.
