If your pet becomes ill we will call the emergency number listed above regarding your pet's symptoms, treatment options, and estimate of additional cost. Please note that if your pet presents with a life threatening or severe quality of life emergency, and we are unable to reach anyone on the listed contacts, we reserve the right to treat the patient accordingly at the doctor's discretion to save their lives and make them comfortable until your return at your expense. We will keep the cost as basic as possible, but in the best interest of your pet and in the interest of humane compassion, we will treat them if needed.

Vaccine/Exam Policy.

All pets left for boarding must be current on ALL required vaccines. This is for the safety of your pet as well as others. Also, every pet who stays at OSAH is required to be checked annually with one of our doctors to review and update any medical concerns and issues.

Canine: Rabies, DHPPC, and Bordetella (every 6 months). Fecal and Heartworm testing within the last year are also required.

Feline: Rabies, FVRCP, and a fecal test within the last year.

*Please note, it is in your pet's best interest to get vaccines done 2 weeks prior to boarding so as not to weaken their immune system right before boarding.

Flea Free Environment.

In order to maintain a "flea free" environment, your pet will be checked for fleas upon arrival and will be administered a Capstar on arrival and every 7 days while here. If fleas or ticks are present and the capstar does not take care of it, your pet will be treated with flea medication (at the doctor's discretion) at your expense.
