Boarding Policies Hurricane Addendum

During hurricane season from June 1st until November 30th each year, special emergency provisions should be in place when bringing your pet(s) in for boarding at our hospital. When checking in for boarding, our staff should be provided with emergency contact information for hurricane purposes as well as for questions regarding treatment. If a hurricane is approaching our area and the hospital deems it in the best interest of our staff to evacuate, we must be able to reach your emergency contact promptly who in turn must be willing to promptly pick up your pet(s) to follow your/their own evacuation plans.

We cannot be responsible for pets left at our clinic in the event of a hurricane. Please understand that if pets are left here at the hospital in the case of a serious storm, it could be a matter of days before someone can get back to our area to take care of these pets. Also, the hospital may likely be left without power and therefore without air conditioning. If pets require medication, there may be days that no one can be available to administer medication.

We at Barry Veterinary Hospital want only the best care for your pet and hope you understand the need for evacuation of the hospital in the event of a serious storm. By signing below, you acknowledge receipt of this hurricane addendum to our boarding policies, agree to have emergency evacuation plans in place for your pet, and further to release Barry Veterinary Hospital, Inc. of responsibility for your pet in the event of a such a storm.
