



Night Riding Schedule – Reining Overview

Starting Thursday, September 25, the warm up schedule for Celeste Center during the REINING will be as follows:

- Beginning at 6:00pm (as the show ending provides):
 - 30 minutes of circling followed by 30 minutes of stopping
- Beginning at 7:00pm:
 - Hour/Hour scheduling will commence with circling on odd hours and stopping on even hours.
 - **This will be for the remainder of the show.**
- The Celeste Center arena will be open to ***next day horses only***. Back numbers are **required**.

Friday, September 26

- The arena will be open to reining horses until 7pm
- Beginning at 7pm, arena will be open to next day horses only.
- Arena will be open for riding at 1am.

Saturday, September 27

- The arena will open at the conclusion of the show, after ground maintenance, and be open to next day horses **only** for 6 hours, 3 circling and 3 stopping (Saturday and Sunday). After, open riding for reining horses.
- Arena will close at 5am.

Sunday, September 28

- Arena will be open for horses showing on Monday September 29th after the conclusion of the show and ground maintenance.
- Arena will close at 5am.

Structured Scheduling will be followed from Monday, September 29 through the duration of the reining portion of the show.

Monday, September 29:

- Arena will be open after the conclusion of the show and ground maintenance. The first four hours will be for the next day futurity horses only. The following two hours will be for Wednesday futurity horses only, followed by four hours for amateur horses. Any remaining time will be open riding.
- Arena closes at 5am.

Tuesday, September 30:

- Arena will be open to futurity horses only following the conclusion of the show and ground maintenance for 4 full hours (2 full circle hours and 2 full stop hours).

- It will then remain open until 5am for any next day horses only.

Wednesday, October 1:

- Arena will be non pro futurity horses only following the conclusion of the show and ground maintenance for 4 full hours (2 full circle horses and 2 full stop hours).
- It will then remain open until 5am for any next day horses only.

Thursday, October 2:

- Arena will be green reiner horses only following the conclusion of the show and ground maintenance for 6 full hours (3 full circle horses and 3 full stop hours).
- It will then remain open until 5am for open riding.

Friday, October 3:

- Arena will be open to youth horses only following the conclusion of the show and ground maintenance for 4 full hours (2 full circle horses and 2 full stop hours).
- It will then remain open until 5am for open futurity finalists only.

Saturday, October 4:

- After ground maintenance, Short Stirrup riders will have the arena for 1 full hour (30 minutes circling and 30 minutes stopping).

- It will then remain open until 5am for next day horses only.

Sunday, October 5:

- Arena will be open to non pro derby horses only following the conclusion of the show and ground maintenance for 4 full hours (2 full circle horses and 2 full stop hours).
- It will then remain open until 5am for open riding.

Monday, October 6:

- Arena will be open to open derby horses only following the conclusion of the show and ground maintenance for 6 full hours (3 full circle horses and 3 full stop hours).
- It will then remain open until 5am for open riding.
