## **Congress Split Procedure for:**

# Showmanship, Horsemanship, and Hunt Seat Equitation (scored then ranked)

1-60 entries drawn

Run in one split call back top 20 cumulative scores for \*rail work

o Announcer assistant will provide each Judge with his/her scores of those entries that have made the rail work.

#### 61-120 entries drawn

- Run in two splits (total number of entries divided by two to determine the number of entries per split).
- Call back top 10 cumulative scores from each split resulting in 20 who will rework the pattern.
  - o The new random draw for rework will be generated by the announcer assistant and then forwarded to gate printer.
- Those 20 will then be called back for \*rail work.
  - Announcer assistant will provide each Judge with his/her scores of those entries that have made the rail work.

#### 121-180 entries drawn

- Run in three splits (total number of entries divided by three to determine the number of entries per split).
- Call back top 10 cumulative scores from each split resulting in 30 who will rework the pattern.
  - o The new random draw for rework will be generated by the announcer assistant and then forwarded to gate printer.
- Call back top 20 cumulative scores for \*rail work.
  - o Announcer assistant will provide each Judge with his/her scores of those entries that have made the rail work.

\*In Showmanship there is no rail work - the top 20 cumulative scores will be called back for final placings and awards. To assist with final rankings, each judge will be provided a list of the returning back numbers in the order of their individual scores. Reminder that not all of a judge's top 20 will be in the cumulative top 20.

### Final Placings

Judges rank 15 based on scores from last run along with rail work (no rail work with Showmanship - see above to place based on provided report).

## **General Scoring Procedures for:**

# **Equitation over Fences, Working Hunter (only rank)**

Each judge keeps their own scores and ladder sheet - judges rank 15.

## Roping, Reining, Trail, Western Riding, Ranch Riding, Ranch Trail (scored)

Provide individual scores to ring steward after each run.

## Longe Line (scored then ranked)

Provide individual scores to ring steward. Call back top 20 cumulative scores for awards

o Announcer assistant will provide each Judge with his/her scores of those entries that have been called back into the arena for awards.

### Final Placings

Judges rank 15 from the top 20 cumulative scores. To assist with final rankings, each judge will be provided a list of the back numbers with the top 20 cumulative scores listed in the order of their individual scores. Reminder that not all of a judge's top 20 will be in the cumulative top 20.

# Hunter Hack (scored then ranked)

Provide individual scores to ring steward. Top 20 cumulative scores will be called back for rail work.

o Announcer assistant will provide each Judge with his/her scores of those entries that have made the rail work.

## **Final Placings**

Judges rank 15 based on scores from fence and rail work.
