The Scrum framework is purposefully incomplete, only defining the parts required to implement Scrum theory.







- Focus on Customers/Users




Evidence-Based Management™

An empirical approach that helps organizations continuously improve





Kanban (n): a strategy for optimizing the flow of value through a process that uses a visual, work-in-progress limited pull system.




Kanban for Scrum Teams - Core Practices

- 1. Visualization of the Workflow
- 2. Limiting Work in Progress (WIP)
- 3. Active management of work items in progress
- 4. Inspecting and adapting the team's Definition of Workflow


