



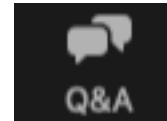

- Target – 1st integrated release in 90 Days

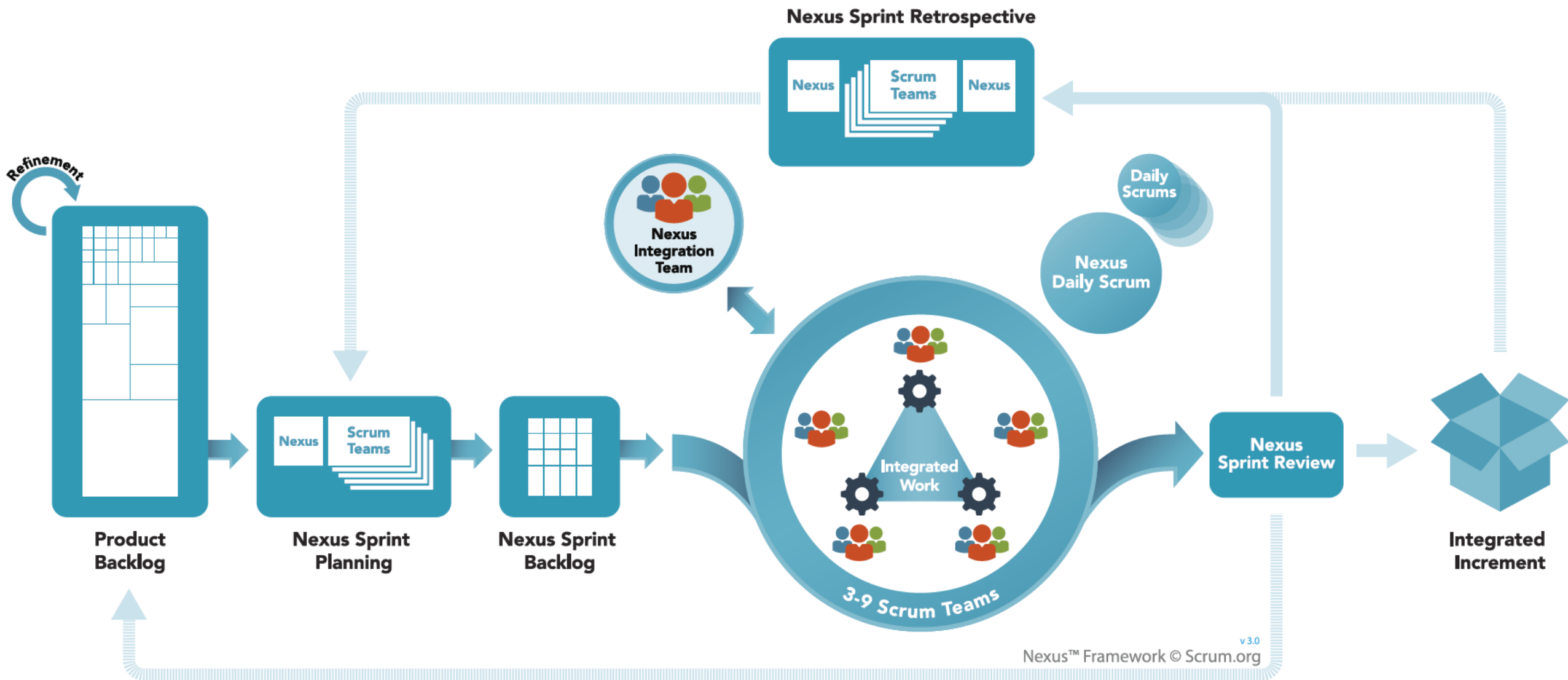

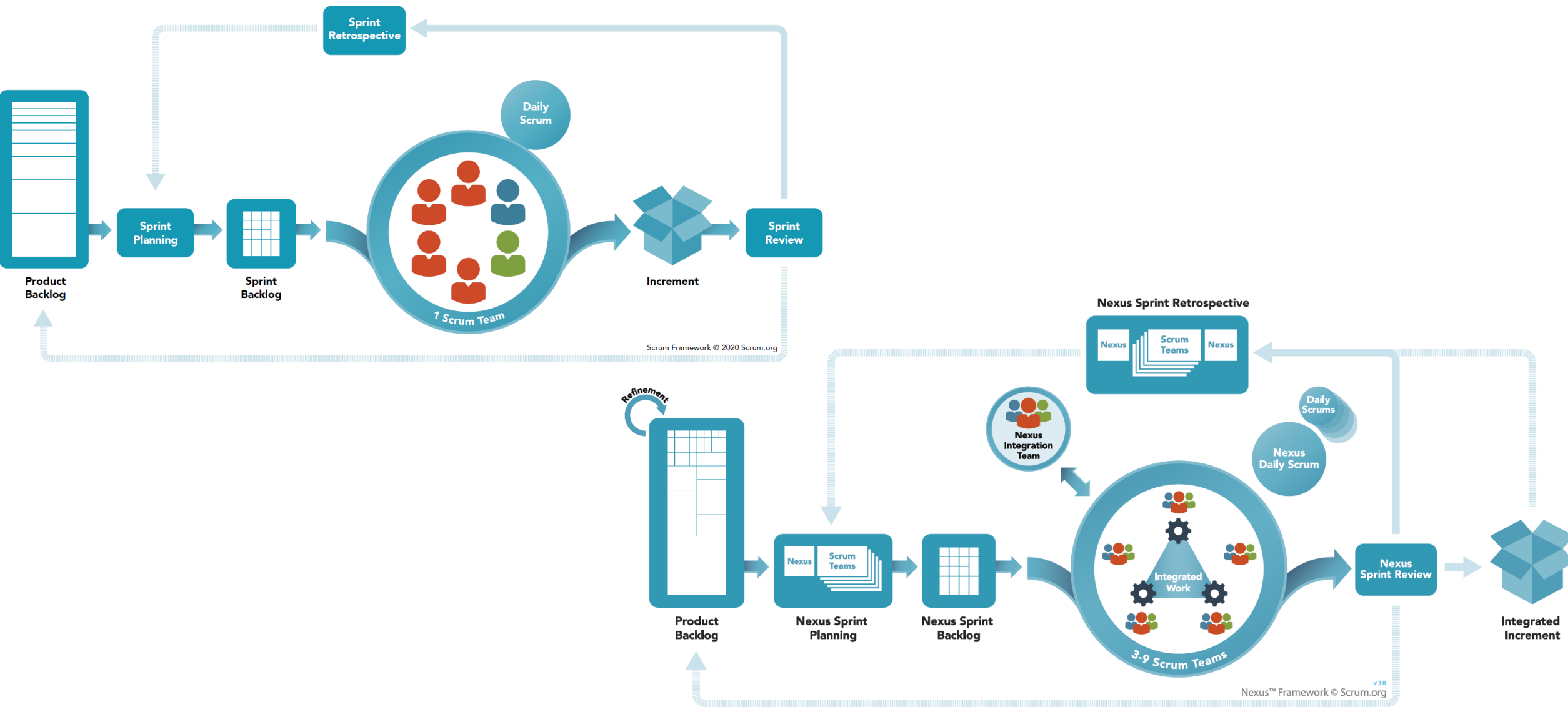

NEXUS BUILDS ON SCRUM



NEXUS WITH JIRA & ADVANCED ROADMAPS FOR JIRA

- Design Principles and Philosophy
 - Individuals and Interactions over Processes and Tools
 - Use an empirical approach when designing and configuring your processes and tools
- Jira
 - One 'Jira Project' = One Product
 - Building your Nexus Backlog/Board – single source of truth
 - Scrum Team Boards and Configuration
- Advance Roadmap
 - How to map your boards and teams
 - Using roadmaps for cross-team refinement and Nexus Sprint Planning
 - Bottom up intelligence and forecasting
 - Initiatives (optional)

NEXUS WITH CONFLUENCE

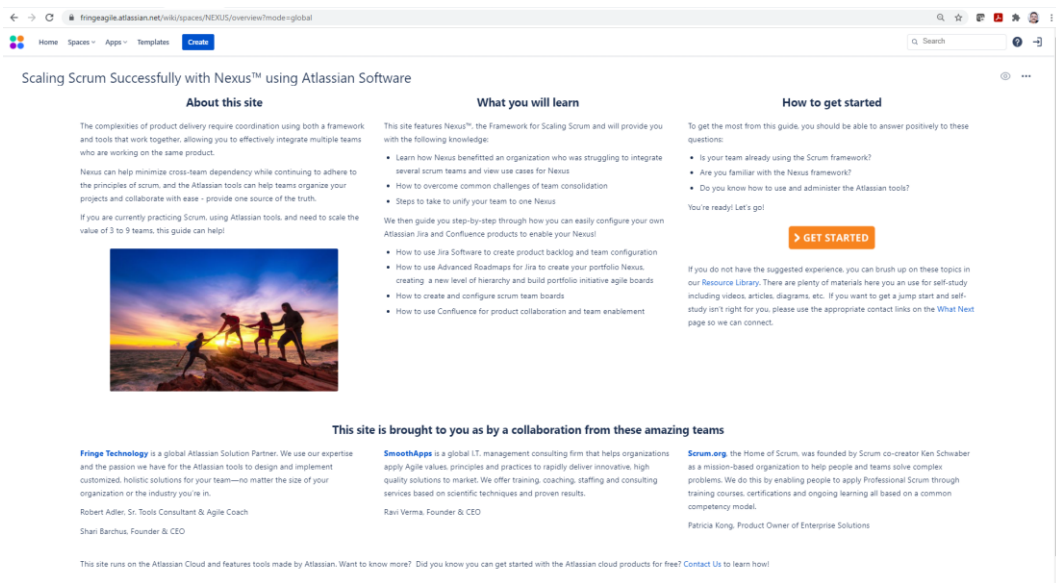
- Prepare Confluence before your 1st Sprint
 - Create your Nexus space
 - Create your team roster
 - Create a calendar for the Nexus
 - Document your teams' working agreements and DOD
 - Link your space to your “Advanced Roadmaps for Jira” plan
 - Start using Confluence templates or create your own
 - Individuals and Interactions over Processes and Tools
 - Use an empirical approach when designing and configuring your processes and tools

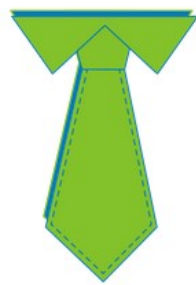

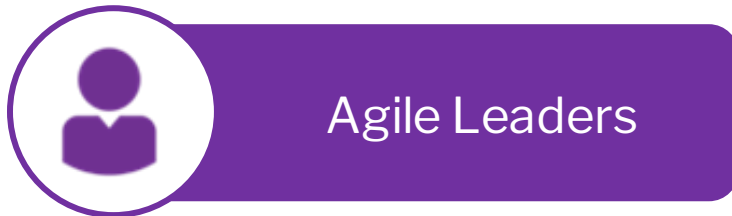
