There are three levels of Professional Scrum Master & Professional Scrum Product Owner Certifications (fundamental, advanced and distinguished) that validate and certify your knowledge of Scrum and ability to apply that knowledge.

Professional Scrum Master™



Level 1 - Fundamental

PSM I certification holders have proven that they understand Scrum as described in the Scrum Guide and how to apply Scrum in Scrum Teams. PSM I holders have a consistent terminology and approach to Scrum.



Level 2 - Advanced

PSM II certification holders have proven an understanding of the Scrum Master accountabilities, how the Scrum Team functions and the underlying principles of Scrum and can effectively apply Scrum in complex, real-world situations.



Level 3 - Distinguished

PSM III certification holders have proven knowledge of how to coach, facilitate, mentor and teach Scrum Team members while influencing the overall organization and a deep understanding of the application and practices of Scrum and the Scrum Values.

Professional Scrum Product Owner™



Level 1 - Fundamental

PSPO I certification holders demonstrate a fundamental understanding of the Scrum framework, and how to apply it to maximize the value delivered with a product including the minimum knowledge of the Product Owner accountabilities.



Level 2 - Advanced

Product Ownership knowledge and
understanding of how the Scrum
framework supports the creation of
value including the topics:
product vision, product backlog
management, release and
portfolio planning, business strategy,
and working with stakeholders.



Level 3 - Distinguished

PSPO III holders demonstrate a distinguished level of understanding for how to own a vision, manage a Product Backlog, and engage with stakeholders & customers to deliver valuable products using Scrum while being effective in a variety of complex team and organizational situations.

PSD I certification holders demonstrate a fundamental understanding of how to deliver quality software using the Scrum framework while working in Scrum Teams including the application of modern Agile and DevOps practices.



Scaled Professional Scrum™

SPS certification holders demonstrate a fundamental understanding of skills that can be applied to overcome challenges when scaling Scrum beyond a single Scrum Team, and the use and details of the Nexus framework.



Professional Scrum™ with Kanban

PSK I certification holders demonstrate a fundamental understanding of how to improve the way of working by applying Kanban practices in the context of Professional Scrum including the importance of flow.
