



Girl Scout Day Cardboard Regatta Challenge Guidelines

Saturday, June 1st, 10:30 a.m.: Hurricane Harbor – Hurricane Bay

Prior to Girl Scout Day build a cardboard boat made of only cardboard and duct tape, large enough to carry a minimum of two people, and bring it to the challenge located inside Great Escape at Hurricane Bay. You will race your boat in the wave pool and have a chance to win prizes! This event is for fun, so get creative and be silly!

Boat Materials and Design:

- Each team will build a boat prior to Girl Scout Day and bring it to Hurricane Bay in time for the 10:30 a.m. race
- Teams are responsible for purchasing and/or gathering their own materials for construction. Design is left to builder(s). Let your imagination take over! The ENTIRE boat must be built from cardboard & duct tape. NO other materials or waterproofing may be used on the boat. NO gasoline, benzene, propane or other chemical or electrical propulsion systems are permitted.
- No paint or markers that will bleed into the water are permitted.
- Each team can provide their own paddles
- The crew compartment CANNOT be enclosed so as to interfere with escape.

Race Day:

- You will walk your boat to Hurricane Harbor Bay the morning of the race and check-in at the table next to the wave pool
- Judging will take place right after the last race ends. Prizes will go to: Fastest Boat, Most Creative Boat, Most Team Spirit (think costumes, a theme, t shirts etc)
