Privacy Policy

1. INTRODUCTION

Wideo Inc. (hereinafter "Wideo") respects your privacy and your personal information.

This Privacy Policy ("Privacy Policy" or "Policy") explains how Wideo uses, protects, and discloses the information provided by you ("Users' Information") when you use its web site www.wideo.co (hereinafter, the "Site") or the services provided in it (the "Services"). This Privacy Policy also explains the choices available to you regarding Wideo's use of your information and how you can access and update it.

This Privacy Policy should be read along with Wideo's Terms and Conditions (hereinafter the "Terms and Conditions") posted at the Site. Please read carefully this Privacy Policy and the Terms and Conditions before using the Site and the Services.

2. ACCEPTANCE

Your access to the Site and use of the Services are conditioned on your acceptance to this Privacy Policy and the acceptance of and compliance with the Terms and Conditions. If you do not agree with them, you must not access the Site or use the Services. By using the Site and /or the Services, you signify that they agree to this Privacy Policy as well as to the Terms and Conditions.

3. UPDATES

Wideo reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to change or modify this Privacy Policy or to add, or remove portions of it at any time, so you should check this Privacy Policy periodically. Such changes will become effective thirty (30) days after they have been posted to the Site or Wideo has otherwise notified you of the change. Your continued use of the Site and its services after Wideo posts any such modifications will constitute your acknowledgment of the changes, and your agreement to the new Privacy Policy. Use of Users' Information is subject to the policy in force at the time such Users' Information has been collected.

4. SCOPE OF THE APPLICABILITY

This Privacy Policy only applies to information collected through the Site and does not extend to anything that is inherent in the operation of the Internet, and therefore beyond Wideo's control.

5. INFORMATION COLLECTED

"Your Information" or "Users' Information" comprises as follows:

5.1. Users' Personal Information. Your Personal Information (hereinafter, "Personal Information") includes information that pertains to your identity. Such information may include, but is not limited to, your name/s, email address, mailing address, credit card billing information, your name for social media accounts you wish to connect to their account, your image and likeness if you include it in any media content that you upload or include in videos created through the Site. You may choose not to provide your Personal Information; however, in that case, some functions of the Site will not be available to you.

5.2. Information that you provide about others. In some occasions Wideo may collect information from other persons than you (Third persons' Information) when it is provided by you when you use the Site or the Services. In such case you must have the consent of such third persons to upload their information to the Site.

5.3. General Information. Wideo may also collect more general information from you ("General Information"). General Information may include information recorded by Wideo's server logs from Users' browser such as your Internet Protocol (IP) address, and the specific website that you requested. Such General Information, including the click stream data and cookies, as mentioned below, may be collected from you whenever you access or use the Site or its services, whether or not you provide Wideo with any other personal information.

5.4. Click Stream Data. When you use the Site or the Services, Wideo may also collect "click stream data" (server address, domain name, etc.) from you. This information can be combined with information that you have provided, which will enable Wideo to analyze and customize your visits. Wideo may use click stream data for traffic analysis or e-commerce analysis of the Services, to determine which features within the Site and Services are most or least useful to you.

5.5. Cookies. Cookies can be used by Wideo to follow your activity throughout the Site. Cookies are data files stored on your computer after you access certain websites. The information provided by cookies helps Wideo to understand your preferences and to improve your experience.

6. USE OF YOUR INFORMATION

6.1. Wideo uses your Information to provide its services and products to you. Such use includes the following:

- a. To process orders that you may place at www.wideo.co
- b. To assist those who help Wideo in designing and operating the Site or analyze collected Users' Information (hereinafter, "Partners"). The Partners will only use Users' Information for the purpose of carrying out the work as agreed with Wideo and will be required to keep the Users' information confidential.

6.2. Except from the exceptions set forth in this Privacy Policy, Wideo will notify you or obtain your consent before your information is shared with third parties.

7. PROTECTION OF USERS' INFORMATION

7.1. In order to protect Users' Information, Wideo has implemented various security measures. For example, when you enter your sensitive information (such as your credit card number), Wideo encrypt that information using secure socket layer technology (SSL). Wideo also follows generally accepted industry standards to protect your Users' Personal Information both during transmission and once it has been received.

7.2. Notwithstanding the security measures implemented by Wideo, you should keep in mind that whenever you give out personal information online there is a risk that third parties may intercept and use that information. While Wideo strives to protect your Users' Information and your privacy, Wideo cannot guarantee the security of any information that you disclose. By using the Site and /or the Services, you expressly acknowledge and agree that Wideo do not guarantee the security of any data provided to or received.

8. DISCLOSURE OF USERS' INFORMATION

8.1. Wideo may disclose your Users' Information when Wideo believes in good faith that such disclosure is necessary to comply with any law, enforce or apply the Terms and Conditions and other agreements, or protect the rights, property, or safety of Wideo, its employees, customers, or others.

8.2. Wideo may also disclose your Users' Information upon receipt of a court order or subpoena, or to cooperate with a law enforcement investigation, which may include responding to requests and court orders.

8.3. Wideo reserves the right to report any activity that Wideo in good faith believe to be unlawful, as determined in its sole discretion.

9. RETENTION OF USERS' INFORMATION

Wideo will only retain your Users' Information to the extent that: (a) Wideo is required by law to maintain such information; or (b) it is needed for Wideo to address any issues or inquiries that you may have. When your Users' Information is no longer required, Wideo will destroy or erase it.

10. THIRD PARTIES' SITES

In order to improve your usage of the Site and its Services, Wideo may insert links to third party web sites. This Privacy Policy does not apply to such third party websites. These links take you outside the Site and they are beyond Wideo's control. Such sites may have their own separate privacy policy and Wideo is not liable for the content and activities of those sites. Your visit and access to such websites are at your own risk.

11. PAYMENT INFORMATION

Your credit card billing information will also be subject to Wideo's payment processor's privacy policy. Please read the privacy policy on the website of any payment processor that you are directed to, in order to get information about the use, storage and protection of your data before submitting any credit card billing information.

12. BUSINESS TRANSFERS

Wideo may transfer its business. In such case, Users' Information could be one of the business assets that is transferred or acquired by the acquirer. You acknowledge and accept that such transfers may occur, and that any acquirer of Wideo may continue to use your Users' Information as set forth in this Privacy Policy or even change it.

13. MINIMUM AGE REQUIREMENT

In accordance with U.S. Federal Children's Online Privacy Protection Act of 1998 (COPPA), Wideo will never knowingly solicit, nor will it accept, personally identifiable information from users known to be under thirteen (13) years of age. By using the Services you are

warranting that you are 13 years old or more or, in case you are under the applicable age of majority, your parent or legal guardian has read and agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions.

14. CANCELTION OF SUBSCRIPTIONS AND MODIFICATION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

14.1. You may cancel your account and may opt out of receiving any emails from Wideo at any time, by logging in and visitingand following the instructions provided there. You should note that although you may opt out of receiving certain emails, Wideo reserves the right to communicate with you via email regarding specific products and services you have ordered, requested, or inquired about.

14.2. Wideo encourages you to update your Personal Information when it changes. Information concerning your past behavior with the Service may be retained by Wideo as long as necessary for the purposes set out above.

15. NOTICES AND QUESTIONS OR COMMENTS
