The 22 Letters of Light are arranged going from right to left. Aleph, Bet, Gimel, Dalet, Hay, Vav, Zayin, Chet, Tet, Yod, Kaf, Lamed, Mem, Nun, Samech, Ayin, Pay, Tzadi, Kuf, Resh, Shin, Tav.

Revised 03/23/23 Gregorian 01/new moon day/6009 Greater-lesser light calendar

Ayin or Ayeen is the 16th letter of the aleph-tav.

Numerical value is 70.

Repeat creation day 2 if counting a weekly cycle according to present day calendars - Yom Sheni. Bet and Tet are on this creation day. Meaning given to the writer: **A person's decision is based on their ability to see darkness and move closer to our Creator's light.**

Sound: silent, pronounced ah'-yeen, has no sound of its own but usually has a vowel associated with it.

English is “A”

Meaning eyes, salvation, to see, to know, to watch, 2 eyes –
wisdom’s eye is generous and the “good and evil” eye is stingy.
One tree in the midst of the garden and the other in the field –
wisdom represents life “good and evil” represents death!

There are 22 chapters in Revelation that match the 22 letters
of the aleph -tav. The 22 letters are supernal (related to the sky
or heavens) light from which everything is created. This
wisdom is seen by the spiritual eye not physical by John.

Chapter 1: **Aleph-Our Creator is eternity.**

Chapter 2: **Bet-Creation is the heavens and the earth.**

Chapter 3: **Gimel-Perfect light is our Creator’s mover.**

Chapter 4: **Dalet-Love opens to eternity.**

Chapter 5: **Hay- Life is the answer to all blessings.**

Chapter 6: **Vav- Discern with courage.**

Chapter 7: **Zayin: rest-The fertile soil has the power of life.**

Chapter 8: **Chet: Meditation in silence brings peace.**

Chapter 9: **Tet- Decision, truth-Once the Creator is formed
within, humankind flees from darkness.**

Chapter 10: **Yud-Our Creator is one forever and ever.**

Chapter 11: **Kaf- Return to our Creator and regain your health.**

Chapter 12: **Lamed- Power is in the words we speak.**

Chapter 13: **Mem- Here is wisdom! Memory-Return to nature.**

Chapter 14: **Nun- Children and simplicity go together.**

Chapter 15: **Samekh- Circle, eternity, ring -Awakened to truth.**

Chapter 16: **Ayin- to see with spiritual eyes-Mature, complete and balanced.**

Chapter 17: **Pay- to speak –Wisdom is a choice, a law of creation.**

Chapter 18: **Tzadi- Enlargement is expansion of the heavens or memory word power.**

Chapter 19: **Kuf- Discernment is love, life and light forever and ever.**

Chapter 20: **Resh- We are all eternal beings and live forever. This is a law of creation.**

Chapter 21: **Shin- Remember the blessings of fruit.**

Chapter 22: **Tav- Our Creator is eternity.**

The Creator's light is far greater than the light that emanates from the sun and stars.

Though concealed in the scriptures, the eternal eye can behold the presence of this radiance, but only by means of the inner eye.

Ayin is sometimes described as having 2 eyes that connect to a common optic nerve that leads to the brain. The 2 eyes

represent either the tree of knowledge of good and evil or the tree of life. Depending on what the optic nerve is connected to (the tree of knowledge of good and evil or the tree of life) will show the actions in that person's heart. We can either use the eye of wisdom or the good and evil eye to perceive things: "Oh, my, I have a flat tire how terrible!" or "Maybe this flat tire has delayed me for a good purpose I cannot see."

Ayin like the letter Aleph is a silent letter. It is said that Ayin sees but does not speak, therefore represents the attitude of humility (anavah) Anavah begins with an Ayin, as does the word for service avodah. On the other hand Ayin can represent idolatry (avodah zara) as well as slavery (the mark put on Cain), both idolatry and slavery which are born out of the heart of **envy** which leads to anger then death.

The heart and eyes are the spies of the body: they lead a person to transgress or return to creation; the evil eye from the tree of good and evil sees, the heart covets, the body transgresses or the eye sees from the tree of life, wisdom, and eternal understanding that all things are for their growth and remains humble and quiet, and return to our Creator's for an answer and not the world's confusing response.

A person is said to be olam katan a miniature world. The eye (circle) reflects the world outside and reveals the world inside. If the inside is evil, it will think evil about something. If the eye has wisdom it will see light in all things.

The inner eye is the light of the body.

If thine inner eye be singular (simple, clear, uncomplicated, pure) thy whole self will be full of light. Yet if thine inner eye be impure thy whole self shall be full of darkness. Therefore, if the light that is in thee be darkness how great is that darkness.

Let's look at the word simple, uncomplicated- it does not mean simple as in insignificant, but simple as in pure. For example, in metals or compounds in nature, there are many complex compounds, but the most powerful are the simplest, such as hydrogen, which is the simplest, the most potent. There is incredible power in hydrogen because of its purity. What we are addressing here is the purity of the heart: how we see. Remove the black spots in the eyes and pureness is all that remains. What is the purest food we can eat? What contains the best water? What food will not bring on thirst? Yes, FRUIT!!!

The Ayin tov (wisdom's eye) will manifest itself in kindness and truth towards others. On the other hand the Ayin hara (good and evil eye) will look to the letter Pay (mouth) considering how it might consume for itself in greed and envy.

The Greek word Soma is usually translated as body but actually means self. The biblical Christ is not talking about the physical body he is talking about Soma-Psychikon, which in Greek means the "soul image". The soul is the reflection of our Creator. So what is being said is if your soul, your heart, is simple and pure, then your soul, your mind will be full of light.

The Greek word for light is “phos”, using the aleph-tav it is “Aur.”

In the gospel of Luke it says: “take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not darkness.” This quote is not superficial. What he is saying here is that the understanding in you can be darkness: “take heed therefore that the light which is in thee be not darkness.” ‘Born from within’ you can see with the light of our Creator. This is the light of Ayin, eternal light. To see with that light, one’s natural eyes have to be open. In other words “Creator formed within.”

“And the serpent {repent is in the word serpent} said unto the woman, “Ye shall not surely die: for Elohim, Yehovah, Hebrew god, doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your (Ayin) eyes shall be opened and ye shall be as Elohim, Yehovah, gods (we know that Elohim, Yehovah is the name for the Hebrew god and this religion has confusion of truth because the true Creator cannot die.) Knowing (Tov), good and (Ra), pollution. And when the women saw that the (ets), tree, was good for food and that it was pleasant to the (Ayin), eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise (however, we know that she misunderstood the word wise as the serpent use the word knowledge and not wise) she took of the fruit thereof and did eat and gave also unto her husband with her and he did eat. And the (Ayin), eyes of them both were opened to unhealthy choices and they knew that they were naked and they sewed fig leaves together and made themselves aprons.”

Adam and Eve, by choice, had their eyes opened. Not to light but to darkness!! Temptation and unhealthy choices are the symbol of our fleshy nature. Because of the fall into temptation their eyes were opened to suffering, darkness, disease and death, the tree of knowledge of good and evil.

The light in us is the light of our Creator- be ye children of light!! This light brings blessings, eternal wisdom, children, land, and freedom.

There is a way to gain wisdom of that light at the root of our being. We know this is true because the word knowledge not wisdom using the aleph-tav is Da'ath. Da'ath comes from the primary word; to know -Yada, yaw-dah. Da'ath has 3 letters: Dalet, Ayin, and Tav. The very middle of that word is Ayin, which is the light, our spiritual eyes. In other words, to have wisdom one must see the word "knowledge" for what it really is. Real knowledge is not wisdom it is **experience**. When you have knowledge it is because you have experienced it not because you know our Creator. The laws of creation you observed their unchanging nature yet not sure of the consequences. Little faith at this time. This is the meaning of Da'ath: knowledge through experience.

We are here to enjoy life abundantly.

Da'ath is attached to the tree of knowledge of good and evil which brings a person eventually to experience unhealthy choices. The eternal minded person knows that he or she will never die as life is all we know.

Look how close the two words look alike- Death and Da'ath.

The Ayin is a split force it is a “Y” and it is split because it is dual: there is light and there is darkness.

Using the aleph-tav the word for tree is “ets” עץ spelled Ayin and Tzadi. These letters look very similar. Both are dual. Both look like an English or Latin “Y”. The tree of life or the tree of lives, because it is plural and is connected to your spinal column, nervous system and brain while the second (purity and impurity) represents the sexual, fleshy nature. This explains the split in the “Y”. Both the tree of life and the tree of good and evil are within a person. As the tree (person) matures they are inclined to one side or the other. Depending on which one you are nurtured from will determined if you ascend to light or descend to darkness. “And out of the ground Yehovah, the name of the Hebrew god, made every tree grow that is pleasant to the sight and nourishment for food, with the tree of life-wisdom in the midst of the garden and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, death, outside the garden. But the fruit of the tree which is in the field, Yehovah, Hebrew god, has said do not eat of it nor touch it lest you die. *There can be only one tree in the midst of the garden and that tree is the tree of life otherwise it cannot be called middle or midst. Two things cannot occupy the same space at the same time.*

Out of the dust of the earth man was created so therefore, we have the same composition to our DNA as do the trees and plant life that were formed from the ground.

So the tree of knowledge of good and evil and the tree of life are in us. The DNA is hidden inside your spinal column, brain, endocrine system. It is from these places that we are nourished from the plants and fruit trees of the earth and our life emerges, yet if we abuse the body- eating meats and processed foods, we create suffering and disease, the tree of knowledge of good and evil. One abuses oneself by eating from the wrong tree.

This is abundantly evident in our world today. Those who eat from the tree of knowledge of good and evil abuse their mind, heart and body which creates suffering, disease and short life.

“Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles? Even so every perfect tree brings forth perfect fruit; but a corrupt tree brings forth evil fruit. A perfect tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth perfect fruit. Every tree that brings not forth perfect fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire. Wherefore, by their fruits ye shall know them.”

Wisdom is a tree of life bearing perfect fruit!

Proverbs 3:13-18 pg. **732**. She is a tree of life to those taking hold of her and blessed are all who retain her. Proverbs 11:30 pg. **739** “the fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who is

winning lives is wise.” Proverbs 13: 12 pg. **740**- “Expectancy drawn out makes the heart sick, but a longing come true is a tree of life.” Proverbs 15:4 pg. **742** – “A healing tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in the tongue crushes the spirit.”

What matters is our eternal vision which begins with tiny indications of what is right and wrong as a child and then, becomes greater and greater for right and for wrong as we sojourn upon the earth. We call it “born from within”. “Born from within” starts the tiny mustard seed of faith to increase your love for our Creator. When that seed of the promise (children of light) is accepted, fed, developed and nourished you birth the Creator of light in you. You become children of light ascending and descending on the ladder of letters.

The light is within us, the light is there, you just need to go outside and be in nature. Wisdom, which brings the words of light, needs to fill us yet it can only do that if the darkness is removed. When the light begins to emerge inside of your mind and heart, you become a different person, distinct, in the act of being “born from within”. This is how your whole being becomes filled with light. This is Ayin filled with light. In that way you can return to creation in the state of humility as this person has returned to our Creator with all their heart, mind, body and soul.

“Let your light so shine before men, that they may **ע**”
[Ayin, see] your perfect works of our Creator.

The meaning of being a leader is to visualize-see-born from within and convey this message to others. As such, one thereby transforms the Ayin to the Ayin of the Shema – where one can lift up one's eyes and see creation as pure satiated truth!

8 affirmations of Ayin:

1. Our Creator springs in me living fruit.
2. Thank you for giving me wisdom's eye – generous and loving, long suffering, pure with the heart of peace. Creation never return void.
3. Watching all things for a tender voice on a daily basis.
4. We all have been given a body and a heart so no one can say –“I was made evil” Our Creator made us perfect beings that inhabit a male or female body with loving attributes and character. It is for us to return to creation.
5. Those who do not know our Creator and laws of creation are “poor.” We children of light are rich –none are in want. We are discerners.
6. As overcomers we push others to move to higher ground- to seek out truth and the Creator of all.
7. And the Truth will set you free!
8. The Creator will never leave us. We love ourselves and others.
