The 22 Letters of light are arranged going from right to left. Aleph, Bet, Gimel, Dalet, Hay, Vav, Zayin, Chet, Tet, Yod, Kaf, Lamed, Mem, Nun, Samech, Ayin, Pay, Tzadi, Kuf, Resh, Shin, Tav.

The letter G in English.

Gamateria or numerical value is 3.

The “third day” of creation is Yom Shlishi on the greater-lesser light calendar. Tuesday is the third day of the week on the Gregorian calendar. Written with letters of light this way: **יום שלישי**

The letters of light are Yud, Shin, Yud, Lamed, and Shin. The understanding given to the writer: **The heart of order and peace is a refinement, the heart of order and peace is the teacher that cleans by the word of truth awakened within.** Eat fresh fruits and vegetables and nuts for the best energy resource to be established in your mind and organs. These vegetables and fruits are fired by the sun and gives the body all the breath and water needed for the body.

Gimel is composed of 2 letters- the first is a Vav, representing one with our Creator. To the left side is the second letter, a Yud, which signifies both the foot and the act of giving due to humility. In our own lives we find that the upper body, from waist up, has a tendency toward selfishness, the predisposition to “take”. Our intellect often exists for itself, applying its faculties to secure its needs. The mouth, stomach, and digestive tract are employed in the intake of food and drink. The lower portion of the body, however, is the part that gives to others. With our legs we walk distances in order to help another person. Our hands and fingers do acts of kindness and heart love. The Yud can also represent the reproductive organ, the seedbed of human life fulfilling a law of creation to be “fruitful and replenish the earth.”

The word Gimel is similar to the word gamal which means camel using the aleph-tav.

The reason that the Hebrews say that the number 3 represents Torah or scripture is because the people at that time were given the first 5 books of scriptures in the third month of the year to Moses (he was the third child of 3 children).

“Prepare for the 3rd day do not approach a women”- so for 3 days no man was to know his wife until the 10 commandments were given. The first five books of scripture was issued to a people of three groups: the Kohanim (priests), the Levites and the Israelites. Finally, the Torah itself is divided into 3 segments: 5 books of Moses (Torah teachings), the prophets (Nabi-naw-bee from naw-baw, naba – a prime root to prophesy i.e. speak by inspiration in prediction or simple discourse from an inspired man or woman. Light letters are: Nun, Bet, Yud, Aleph. The understanding given to the writer: **The mature seed delivers to the world or home all things revealed from our Creator** and the scriptures/writings (Using aleph-tav mik-tawb from the root word kaw-thab –meaning a thing written –the characters, a prime root to grave, to write. Light letters are Kaph, Tav, and Bet. The understanding given to the writer:-**Our Cover, love, life and light protects the awakened ones in their homes/bodies.** Our Creator is the word, the beginning to the end.

The power of the number 3 is its ability to combine two different forces to bring about integration – (when separate

people or things are brought together) –male and female.
Aleph and Bet. **So Gimel has the ability to bring attracting but distant forces together through humility (mature discernment).**

Let's say a person is born into the world learning the scriptures. He grows up in a cloistered (monastery or kept away from the outside world, sheltered) society. He goes to yeshivah (scripture study) all his life and all he knows is the scriptures. Finally, this person gets married and goes out into the world and begins to earn a living. He says, "Hey, there's materialistic world out here! There are things besides holiness, besides spirituality. Maybe there are in fact two realities. The first reality is love, life and light, our Creator. Then the second reality, the world. And these two worlds attract each other ..." therefore, scripture is given in the third month because three (movement- there has to be a journey to somewhere to make a difference in the world) has the power to infuse light into the world. Our Creator expects us to make a living (go to a place where others are not awakened) in order to support our loved ones and enlarge heart love. By conducting our worldly affairs according to the wisdom with honesty and integrity we are actually enlarging love, life and light in the physical world. Showing love, life and light to those that have not yet been awakened.

Let's look at it from the point of view of a person that grew up in the world. They ate, drank, partied, and lived by the laws of

the land and government. They were respected in their families and social gatherings. Their work was with good intentions to help others and themselves. Now that person has an encounter of new words of light from within. Not once, but a few times, and begins to see that what they have been taught all their life is not the whole truth. Again, these two worlds attract each other... so how does that person keep a balance in their life and still maintain peace? Gimel is the letter that helps all people to understand their journey of life with their passing over to the awakened side leaving the world an impression of love, life and light to magnify our Almighty Creator.

Three stands for that which is solid, real, substantial, complete and entire.

Our Creator's attributes are 3- omniscience (the state of knowing everything), omnipresence (perfect presence), and omnipotence (the quality of having unlimited power)

Three great divisions completing time: past, present, and future. When all 3 come together through the letter Gimel we arrive at the beginning of the aleph-bet –one. Which is present time.

Three persons in grammar express and include all the relationships of mankind: 1st person, 2nd person, and 3rd person
3 is one of the four perfect numbers.

3 denotes perfect perfection- remember perfection means **mature, complete and balanced**. Interesting, that becoming

perfect in the body will require a person to eat according to the table of creation. On the third day, according to the bible, the kind of food was given to man. This is on the body level and not our being as we remain perfect in being as our Creator made us!

These next examples are Hebraic:

There are 3 parts to the Aaronic blessing: 1-May our Creator bless you and keep you (the first place keep is used in the garden where you are blessed), 2-May love, life and light shine upon you (shine is in the beginning where “Let there be light” was spoken by our Creator), 3- May you become mature, complete and balanced with perfect peace. (Peace is safety, completed in the movement to our Creator, which is accomplished through the letter Gimel in the evening’s rest on each and every prophetic day.

The letters of light for peace is shalom, pronounced shaw-lome, meaning – safe, well, happy, friendly, favor, rest, prosper. The letters of light are: shin, lamed, vav, and closed mem: meaning given to the writer- **The cleansing process by the words of truth- wisdom, connects us to love, life and light words developing maturity.**

Abraham prepared 3 measures of meal- **“The reign of the heavens is like leaven, which a woman took and hid in 3 measures of meal until all was leavened.”** The first part of the sentence is saying that there will be an awakening within to those that seek peace. The next 4 words indicate that there is a

female feeding the awakened. The next 7 words indicate that wisdom, the women, hides her children in 3 equal measurements (present, past and future). The last 4 words mean all 3 measures (that are one) enlarge love, life and light.

On the 3 day of creation the land rose up from out of the water, (indicating a separation from one another- the only way to see the earth was for the earth to be removed from the water, forming earth then the earth listened to the laws of creation and brought forth 3 things; the grass, the plant that yields seed, and the fruit trees whose seed is in itself. “**See**, I have given you every plant that yields seed which is on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed, to you it is for food. **See** using the aleph-tav is spelled ra’ah, pronounced raw-aw meaning appear, behold, experience, gaze, take heed, respect, stare, think, view, vision- letters of light are: resh, aleph hay- meaning given to the writer: **When “born from within” the breath of life, love and light, will pour truth and wisdom into your head, mind, and heart!** Water was never mentioned as being needed to sustain life. All the water was contained in fruits and vegetables at the time of creation. Water flowed from the river of Eden and it watered the garden. The understanding given to this passage of scripture, “Come to truth, all you who are thirsty. Our Creator will give you everlasting water because if you drink from this well you will be thirsty again.” The water here is contained in fruit and vegetables. You have to return to the garden and eat from there to **see** our Creator’s truth.

Meaning of Gimel:

Someone walking- journey, the last word in the 5 first books of the bible end with where the Israelite's journeyed. Today we will see our journey by the lifestyle we lived and the doors we shut behind us as we became awakened to love, life and light.

Gen-(Bereshith) in Egypt

Ex.-(Shemoth) their journeys

Lev.-(Wayyiqra) Sinai

Num.-(Bemidbar)- Jericho

Deut.-(Debarium) Israel, the promise land.

We are all on a love journey. From wandering to a place of settlement from flimsy tents to lasting stones, to an eternal life that does not fade. Those who are not "born from within" live out their lives according to the flesh. They set their minds on things of man's world. Those who have love, life and light set their minds on the things of our Creator, the laws of creation. In this there is life and peace. We are led by the word of truth. Our Creator is awakening all to love, life and light. We are a royal family throughout the earth awakened, complete, mature and balanced.

For we know that if the tent of our earthly house is destroyed, we have a building of love, life and light, a house not made with hands, everlasting and eternal. We are mature beings and live forever. Only the body dies and transforms to dust.

Who is our architect and builder? The architect and builder is our Creator- and we are constantly showing ourselves perfect and one by our words, thoughts and actions.

All life is in a process of running and returning- pulsation of life to finish the race. Remembering our Creator, your race is already won! You are victorious!!

Giving and withdrawing -give an account daily of your actions and the consequences those actions produced.

Harmony – balance- side by side- a spouse should be a benefit-head means to help the other person be all that they can be. Man is not above women, nor women above man but one flesh. Walking together progresses, evenly yoked people. In life, not discouraging each other- a since of harmony to make progress. But two cannot walk together unevenly yoked as no progress will be made and contention and disappointment will be the result. Both must walk with our Creator first and then progress will be the result. When one is not evenly yoked, the awakened one, can be a silent example and bear her or his consequences of choices made. This cannot be avoided because families are made up of those that are awakened and those that are asleep or unconscious to our Creator. The awakened one will always be learning how to be the quiet example with their treasured connection to their Creator.

Another meaning of Gimel is “nourish until ripe.” After Korach rebelled against Moses and Aaron, the word of truth within Moses said, “Take a staff from all the other tribes of Israel.

Then place the staves in the Holy of Holies.” The next morning, Moses brought out the staves from the Holy of Holies and all of Israel saw that the staff of Aaron produced (vayigmal) completely ripened almonds, (Light letters for almonds -Shin, Kuf, Dalet- shaw-kad-a prime root to be alert, i.e. sleepless, to be on the look-out whether for good or ill) The understanding given to the writer: **The tribe of Levi was made perfect to keep watch on the door of the temple.** So of all the tribes, the tribe of Levi- Aaron was completely ripened for this task and no other tribe. Thus the word vayigmal is comprised of the letters Gimel. The tribe of Levi would live out their lives **journeying** with the work of the temple.

We can take this thought of the ripened tribe further down the Hebrew generational line. What child came out of Judah that was fully and totally ripe-written as the first fruit or the awakened of creation? Yes, the biblical Christ.

Another meaning of Gimel is to be weaned. The child grew and was weaned (vayigmal) At first glance, the concepts of being weaned and nourished until ripe seem contradictory. When you are nourishing, you are giving. When you’re weaning, you are ceasing to give. In essence, however, they are consistent, because if you nourish until ripe, you no longer have to give. By the way, every mother and father want this for their children, to be weaned from them, so that they can think on their own because they have been taught our Creator’s ways and wisdom.

The Gimel is also called gamal, or camel. The camel itself embodies the process of weaning and nourishing, as it is able to sustain itself on journeys of vast distance after being sufficiently watered. We also note that Gimel is similar to the word gomel, to be kind and benevolent. The camel is able to help the sojourner survive the harsh desert sun by carrying him to his destination. The word Gimel in Aramaic is gamla or bridge. One can say that the bridge is the humpback of the camel itself, which provides the means and structure to bring people where they need to go physically. Who is our eternal bridge? Who is our MOVER? Our one and only Creator!!

Now, how is it that the Gimel actually signifies the “born from within”, awakened? The answer can be found perhaps in the difference between the terms “heart love” and “Tzedakah”, a teacher of righteousness. “Heart Love” is found in a person that grants mercy to those that are lacking in substance or wisdom. Money will be exchanged. Read the Explanatory notes under “Heart” in the back of the book, “The Scriptures.”

Tzedakah, in contrast, has a fundamentally different meaning. The definition of Tzedakah is righteousness or justice- simply put, to do the right thing, be an example. In the case of Tzedakah, his or her possessions or words of wisdom is unselfish; Our Creator gave it to them unconditionally so that when a lacking person in the word of truth or substance comes along, they can give to them freely. Furthermore, one gives out of love, life and light. You reap what you sow. In order for one

to receive blessings, one needs to do for others in their own home and country, first, then as one is strengthened, to other nations and countries. “This is called Enlargement”

The greatest level of “Heart Love” is not to give money, even though that instantly helps but to give of your time and wisdom to show them how to be self-sufficient and overcome their fears and disease. To set a person on his feet, nourish him until he’s ripe, and then wean him so that he, himself, can know our Creator and wisdom. This is a fully ripened person, perfected and a blessing to others.

The last meaning of Gimel is the MOVER – the perfect example, the word of truth, the Creator awakened within singing joy and peace to all!!!!!!!

8 Affirmations for the letter Gimel:

1. Thank you for the computer sites- connecting to all.
Creating oneness has helped gather thoughts, ideas, and perspectives regarding the Light Letters. Going outside and viewing nature is perfect truth.
2. Aleph, has given me strength. Bet, has a place for me, home is my sanctuary, Gimel-the MOVER of my awakened journey.
3. My eyes are opened to truth- we confront daily, each other, moving to love, life and light, keep me humble.

Feeding those that are asleep and remembering all things with peace is for the benefit of truth.

4. As the camel was to my forefathers, love, life and light, is the true journey and water of life for me.
5. The Aleph to the Tav are my counselors, blessings and health come through eating from the table of creation.
6. Understanding Aleph and Bet brings harmony to marriage- the movement of love.
7. Unite the awakened, I am balanced, ripened, and weaned for this worthy task.
8. Our Creator's light is nourishment- a circle of life in that the seed planted moves through yearly cycles weaning to the next level causing continual eternal growth. And by perfect presence, visiting nature) we become closer to one in perfection.
