

The Biggest Scriptural Mistake of Today's World

Do you actually have God's perfect word?

"God's perfect word" There's the first mistake in this "lesson".


If the Bible you use has replaced HIS NAME with the titles "God" and "Lord", it is perverted!

This is a big problem going back all the way to where it originated, in the Jewish practice and religious laws known as the Talmud. It is within this very practice and document to where it is forbidden to speak the Name of the Father by anyone who is not a Jew and moreover not a high priest and spoken only on high set apart days for religious practice. This is punishable by death if you are not a Jew at the very least, much more even so a priest. Death by beheading is the set method as it is understood. This law is part of what is known as the noahide laws (taken from the Talmud) currently on the books today in every country, but not yet being enforced from what is understood.

We already know that the false mighty one known as Satan, Lucifer, Beelzebub, or Gadre'el among many other names is the elohim of this world as stated by Scripture. This is the part where deception and the perversion of the Scriptures begin without the unlearned knowing about it. The NAMES are a key issue, and especially considering the name of the Father is clearly stated to NOT be taken in vain within the 10 commandments.

Exo 20:7 Thou shalt not take the name of YHWH thy Elohim in vain; for YHWH will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.

What is the Name of our Father in the shamayim (the Hebrew word for heaven)? Well, one has to look at the Aramaic and Hebrew version of the Scriptures before it was translated into Greek. It is the understanding that the semantic people of that time spoke and wrote in Paleo Hebrew. This is important in more ways than one, as the Greek translation has actually removed and replaced the name of the Messiah for their high mighty one, with the name Iesous which is in direct relation to their mighty one called Zeus. This name as Jesus sounding like "hey-zeus" when spoken in the Spanish dialect, is what Iesous has been translated to from the Greek, and not translated from Hebrew. a recent Google search, reveals that Iesous as meaning "healing zeus" (Iesus, and Iesous) which are pagan in origin, and literally translated means "Hail Zeus". Furthermore, the letter J has not been in existence but for approximately 400 to 500 years, making this name Jesus impossible to be the name of the Messiah.

The Paleo Hebrew Name written as  to English becomes YHWH (pronounced as Yahuwah), our Father.

The Paleo Hebrew Name written as  to English becomes Yahushua, our Messiah.

Isa 42:8 I am YHWH: that is my name: and my glory will I not give to another, neither my praise to graven images.

The thing that needs to be understood here is the perversion of the Scriptures in order to hide the NAMES of both the Father and Messiah, replacing them with what seems to be titles, when in actuality, they are calling on false mighty ones. The names or titles such as "God" and "Lord" were used to replace and hide the name of the Father so it could not be known or spoken.

Now this may be somewhat controversial, but looking in the book of Enoch (he walked with Yahuwah and his book is referenced in the Scriptures), we find that the name of the third devil, which is also appearing to be Satan himself, has another name not commonly known... Gadreel. Just like we might say the name of Yah in short for Yahuwah, the name of Gad in short for Gadreel sounds exactly like the "title" we know as "God". What was mentioned before? Who's the "God" of this world?

Book of Hanock (Enoch) 68:6 6 And the third was named Gadre'ël: it is he who showed the children of men all the smittings of death, and he led astray Hawwah, and showed the shield and the coat of mail, and the sword for battle, and all the weapons of death to the children of men.

(Hawwah is known as Eve, who was approached and deceived by the serpent, to which here is revealed his name.)

Ok, so there's the hidden meaning behind that title or name of "God", but what about the title "Lord"? The title lord is in direct reference to Ba'al. The word or title lord refers to someone or something having power, authority, or influence; a master or ruler. It does not refer directly to the Father. Simply put, lord is an idol, false mighty one, master or ruler. Master and ruler are in reference to something in the manner of a boss over an employee, owner of land over their tenants or workers.

Jer 23:27 Which think to cause my people to forget my name by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal.

Rom 2:24 For the name of YHWH is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written.

Halleluyah... have you ever said that? Do you know what it means? It means praise you Yah, or praise to Yah. Yah is the short version of Yahuwah. In the same respect, "God" is short for Gadre'el. Is it possible this is both blaspheming and taking His Name in vain by replacing it with this other name or title? Would you even want to take a chance on such a thing?

Yahuwah clearly tells us to call him by His Name, and to proclaim His Name to the world, not hide it.

Exo 3:15 And Elohim said moreover unto Moses, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, YHWH Elohim of your fathers, the Elohim of Abraham, the Elohim of Isaac, and the Elohim of Jacob, hath sent me unto you: this is my name for ever, and this is my memorial unto all generations.

1Ki 18:24 And call ye on the name of your elohim, and I will call on the name of YHWH: and the Elohim that answereth by fire, let him be Elohim. And all the people answered and said, It is well spoken.

Isa 12:4 And in that day shall ye say, Praise YHWH, call upon his name, declare his doings among the people, make mention that his name is exalted.

Acts 2:21 And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of YHWH shall be saved.

So, keep these things in mind when you speak of any other names than the Name of Yahuwah, and the Messiah Yahushua, because this could be the very “other evangel and other ha’Mashiach (Messiah)” that Paul warned about and cursed twice.

Gal 1:6 I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the favour of the Messiah unto another evangel:

Gal 1:7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the glad tidings of the Messiah.

Gal 1:8 But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other evangel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

Gal 1:9 As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other evangel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed.

Gal 1:10 For do I now persuade men, or YHWH? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of the Messiah.

If we choose to be blind and led by the blind, taking their words as truth without searching the Scriptures for ourselves to find the truth of the matter like those who searched in Acts, then we stumble on the path to where we call on another elohim without even knowing it.

Acts 17:11 These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.

Psa 44:20 If we have forgotten the name of our Elohim, or stretched out our hands to a strange el;

Psa 44:21 Shall not Elohim search this out? for he knoweth the secrets of the heart.

Jer_23:13 And I have seen folly in the prophets of Samaria; they prophesied in Baal, and caused my people Israel to err.

Rom 2:24 For the name of YHWH is blasphemed among the Gentiles through you, as it is written.

2Co 4:4 In whom the elohim of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious evangel of the Messiah, who is the image of YHWH, should shine unto them.

Don't let anything stand between you and your relationship with the Father and Messiah, which means searching Him out for yourself, not someone else searching Him out for you. It is my hope for you that what little has been shown here causes you to look for the truth yourself. I am only a brother in search of truth with you. I am no father, teacher, rabbi, or anything of the sort. There is only one who is Father, and only one who is Rabbi or Teacher.

Mat 23:8 But be not ye called Rabbi: for one is your Rabbi, even the Messiah; and all ye are brethren.

Mat 23:9 And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven.

Mat 23:10 Neither be ye called masters: for one is your master, even the Messiah.

Remember

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Rom 10:13 For whosoever shall call upon the name of YHWH shall be saved.

Rom 10:14 How then shall they call on him in whom they have not believed? and how shall they believe in him of whom they have not heard? and how shall they hear without a preacher?

Act 4:10 Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Yahushua the Messiah of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom YHWH raised from the dead, even by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

Act 4:11 This is the stone which was set at nought of you builders, which is become the head of the corner.

Act 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.

There are two bibles that have the proper names that I know of;
Halleluyah Scriptures – search for this on the internet. I use this one as my personal favorite.
The Scriptures – by Bible Research Institute (I have this one too).

All other bibles that use the names or titles “God”, “Lord”, Jesus or anything else in place of the proper names are to be considered perverted.
