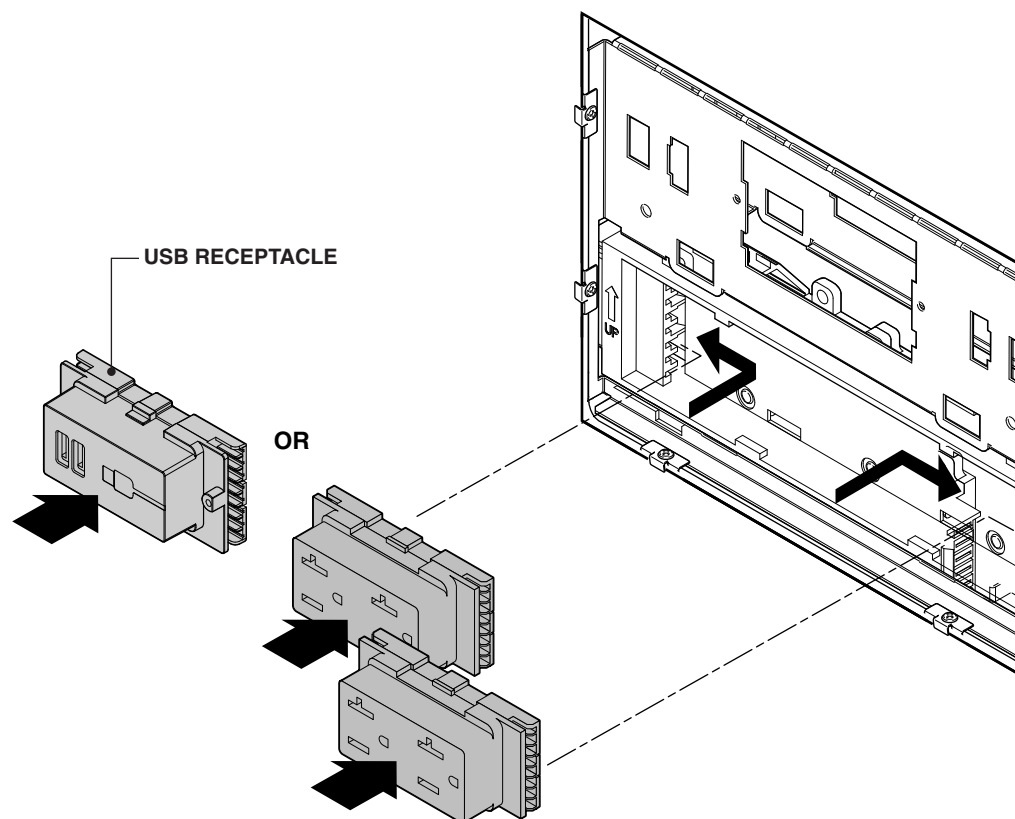


1. Add receptacles before the covers are installed.

2. Insert the receptacle body into the power block and slide toward the side of the power block.
