

INSTRUCTIONS FOR DOUBLE INSULATED PRODUCTS: No grounding means is provided on a double-insulated product. Nor is a means for grounding to be added to the product. The plug looks like the plug illustrated in Figure 1. A double insulated product is marked with the words "double insulation", "double insulated" or 🗇.

GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS (For Grounded Products only) - Some products must be grounded. Connect these types of appliances to a properly grounded outlet in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

For products sold in North America and other 120V regions: the product is for use on a nominal 120-V circuit. No adapter should be used with this product.





Figure 2 Grounding methods




Above Worksurface Mounted Power Cable Routing

NOTE: To optimize the above worksurface power block reach, follow the Blue/A and Green/B diagrams.

NOTE: The above worksurface power block needs to be mounted to the worksurface before installing a Modesty Panel or Privacy Wrap.


Make sure the block is clear from the Modesty or Privacy Wrap mounting holes if either of those are to be added.







Magnetic Cable Clips

Note: If a Privacy Wrap was previously installed there will be additional holes not shown in view above. Modesty panel always installs in the holes closest to the worksurface edge, and closest to the back corner/radius of the desk.
