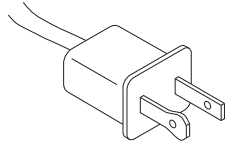

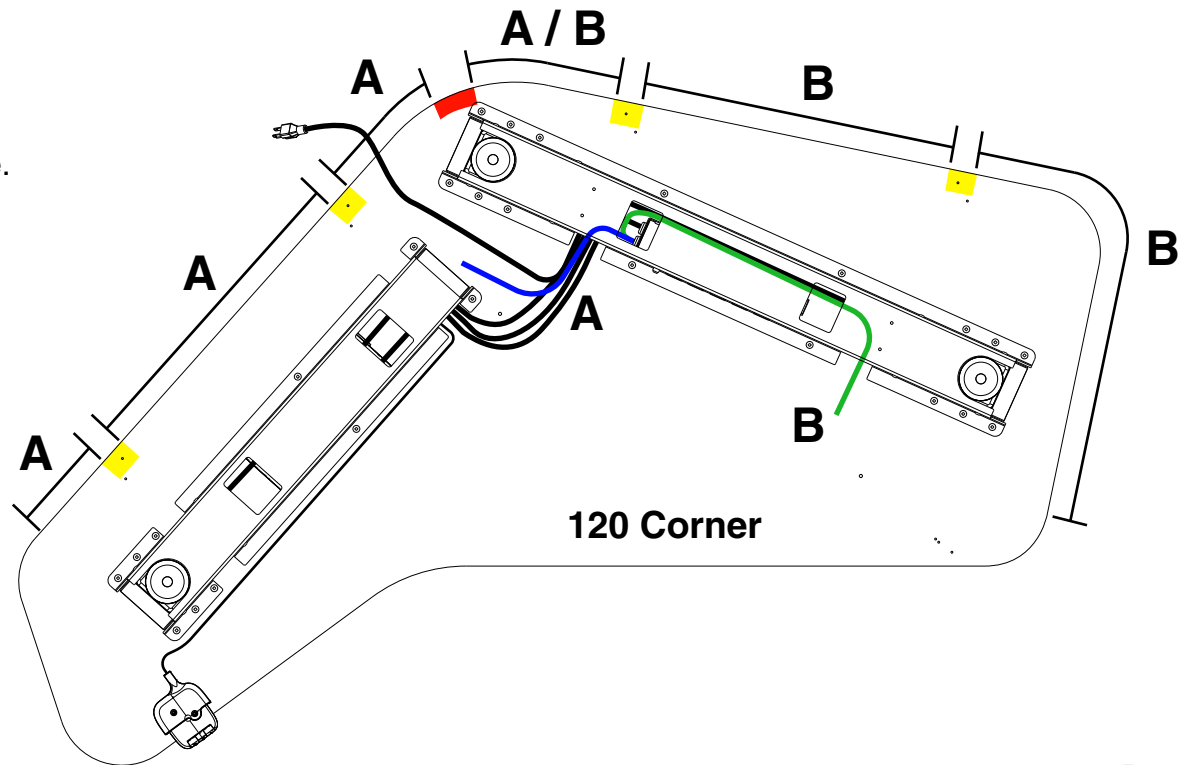
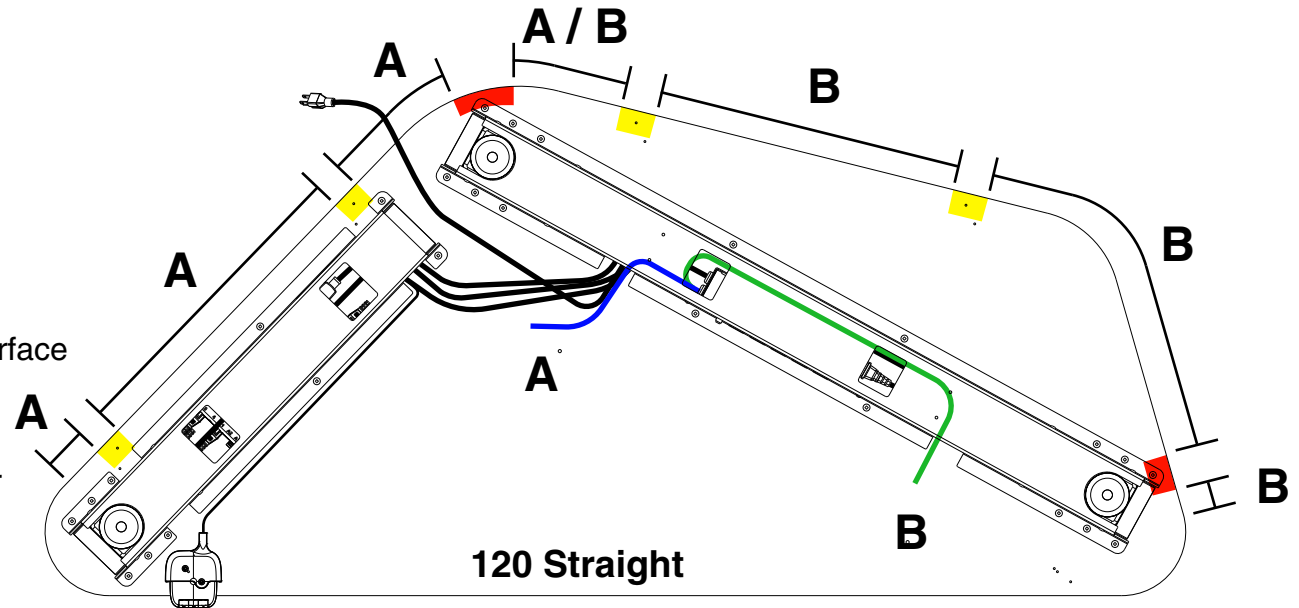


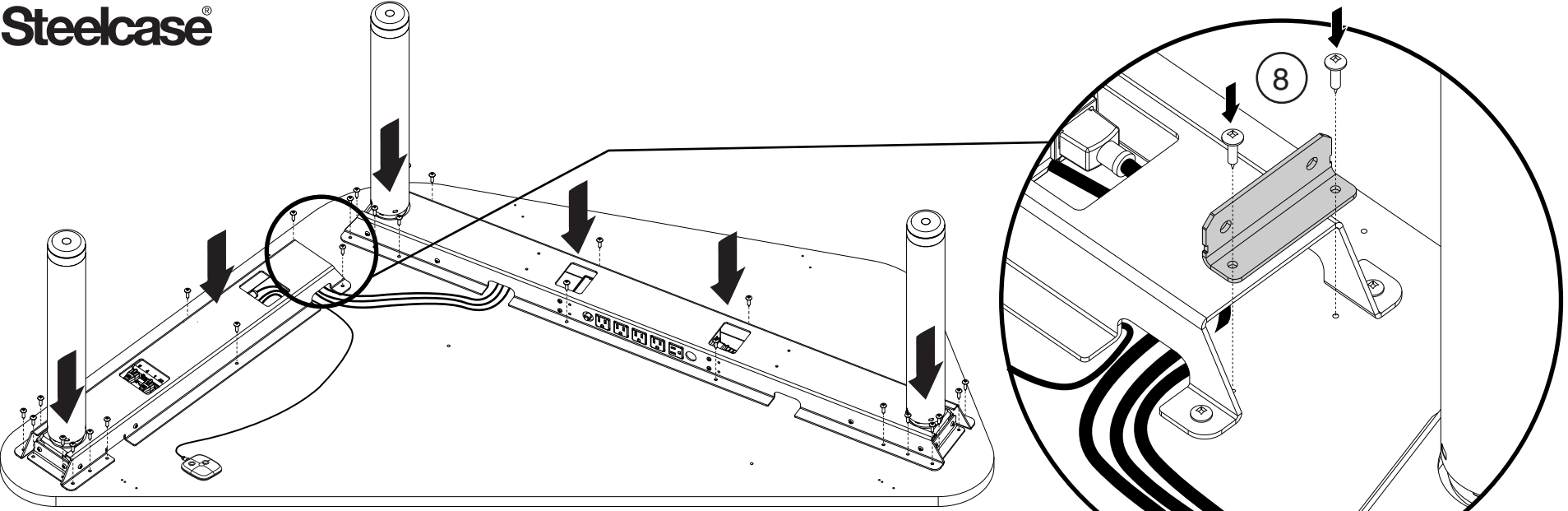
Above Worksurface Mounted Power Cable Routing

NOTE: To optimize the above worksurface power block reach, follow the Blue/A and Green/B diagrams.

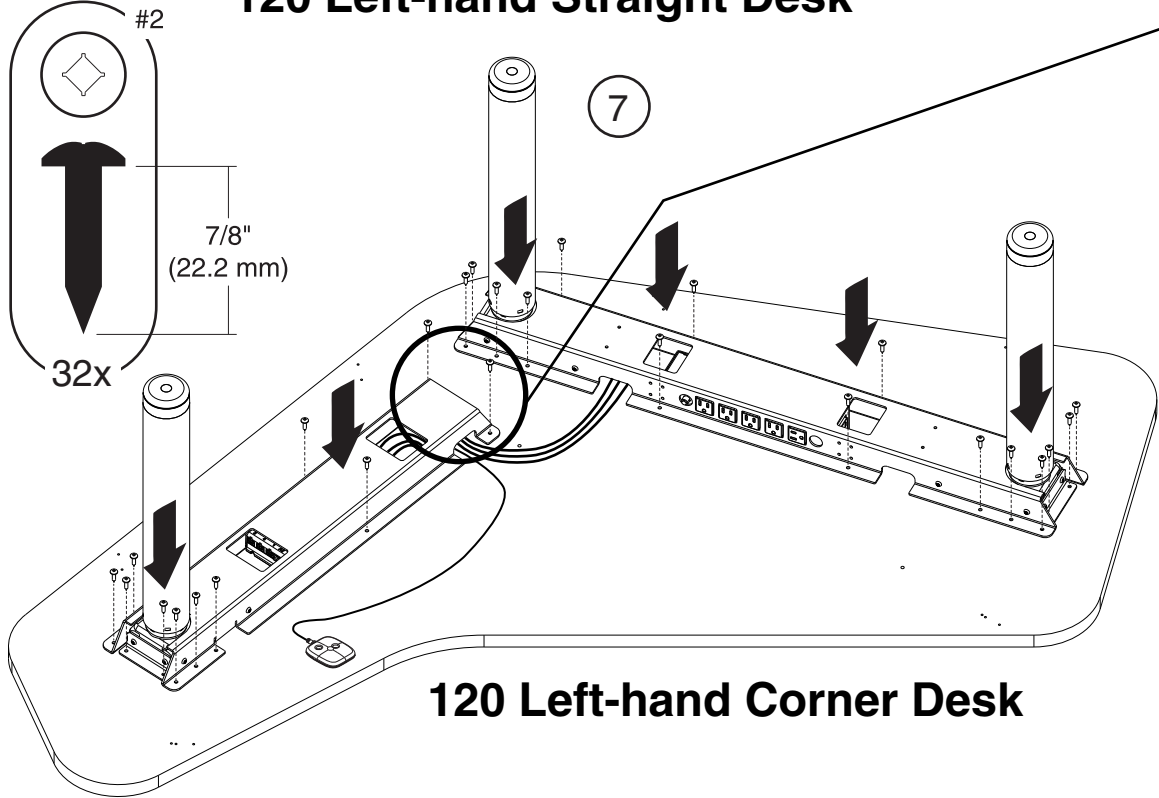
NOTE: The above worksurface power block needs to be mounted to the worksurface before installing a Modesty Panel or Privacy Wrap. Make sure the block is clear from the Modesty or Privacy Wrap mounting holes if either of those are to be added.

NOTE: Above worksurface power can be mounted anywhere along specified edge. Yellow marks are pilot hole locations for Modesty Panel or Privacy Wrap and should be avoided.

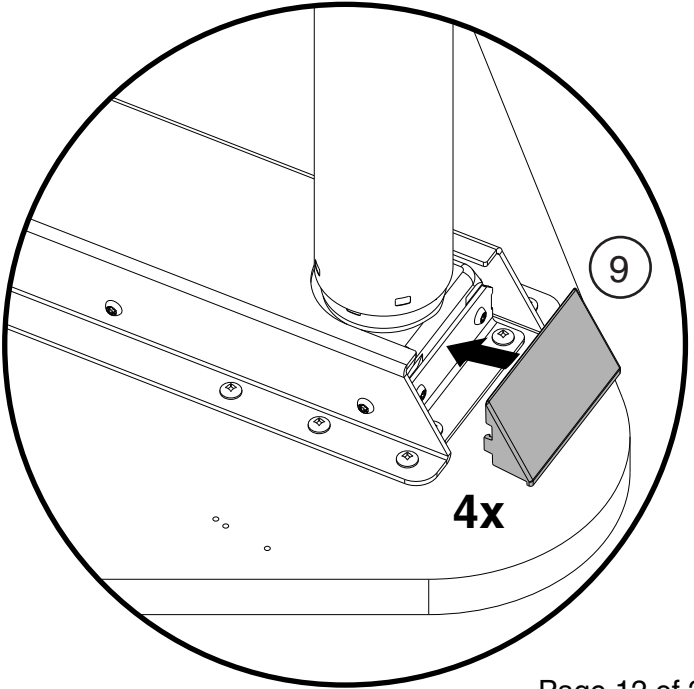


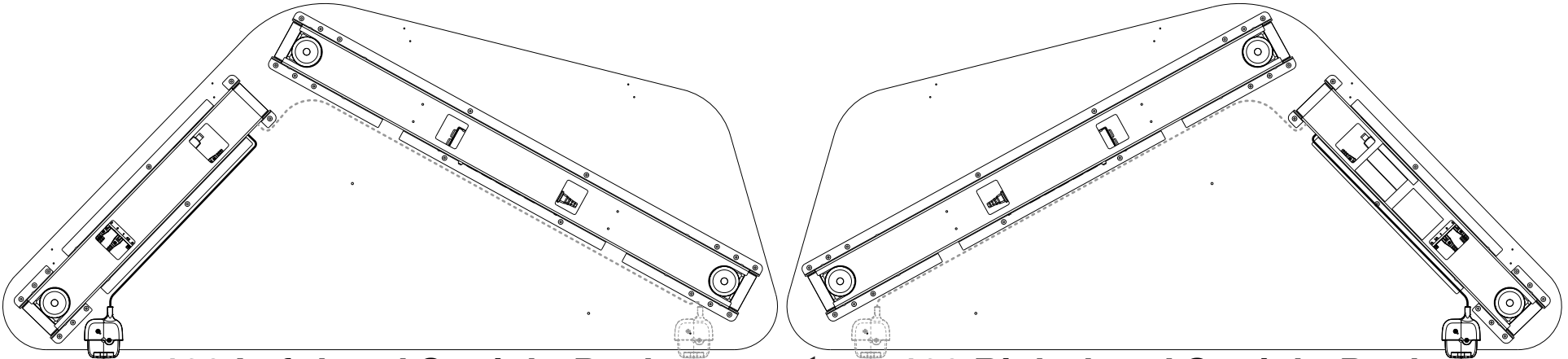

The “green” clip can be adhered to the understructure surface to route cable optimized for desk power cord.

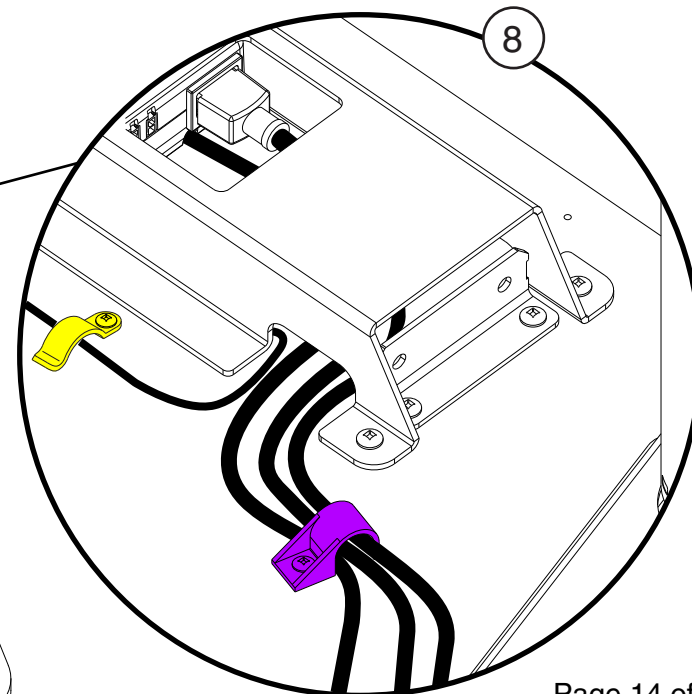

120 Left-hand Corner Desk

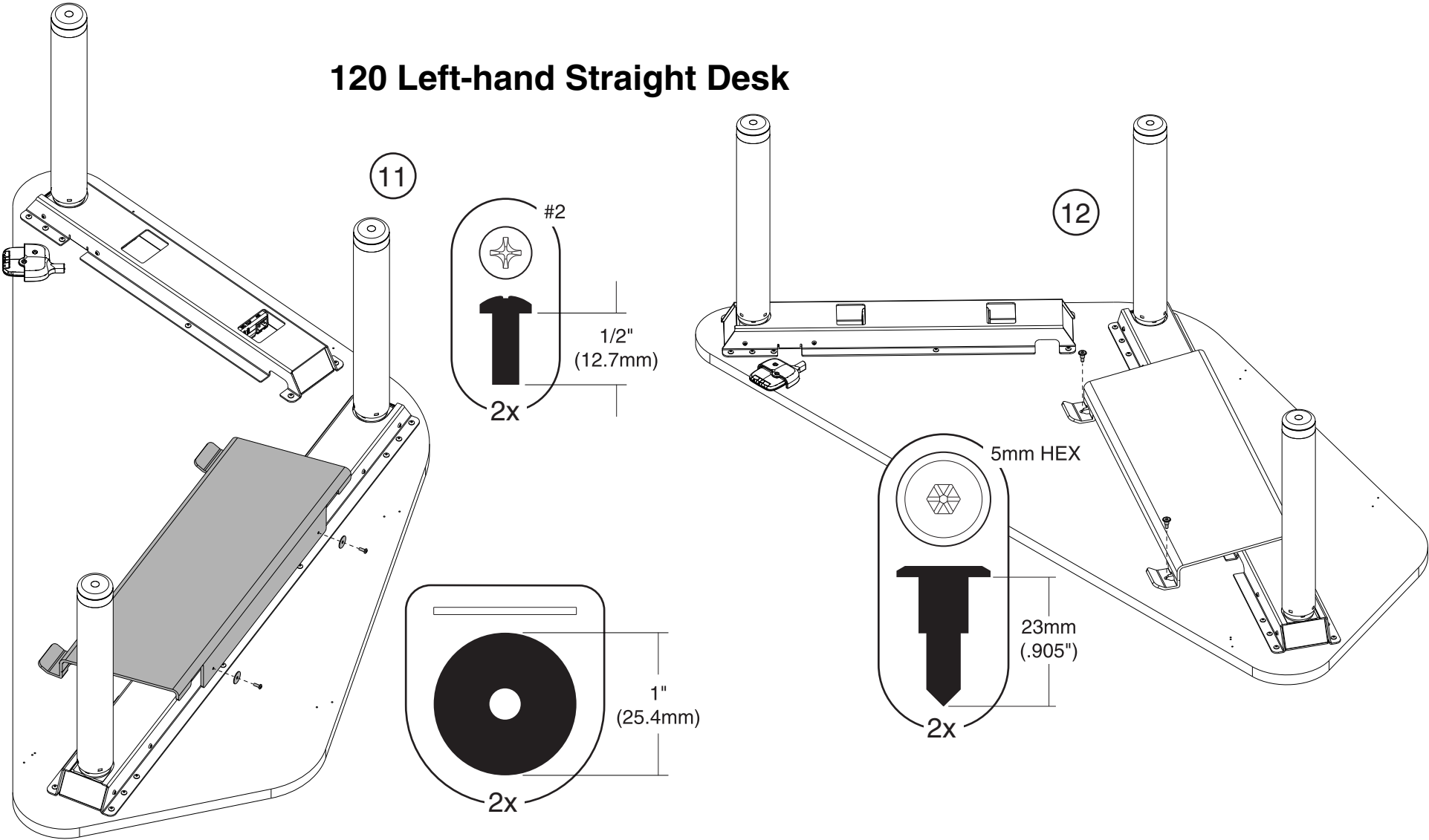
