

Attaching Access Legs to a Chevron, Team or Rectangle Worksurface

1. Place worksurface upside down on a clean, scratch resistant surface, such as on a table.

2. Align the marked identification holes on the leg top plate with the pilot holes as shown. Install #10 x 1" wood screws into the three (3) pilot hole locations (2a). Install six (6) wood screws in the remaining hole locations on the leg top plate (2b).


Example of a marked identification hole.




Align the marked identification holes with the inward most pilot holes.

NOTICE: DO NOT install Access (Fixed Height) legs in the hole pattern for the Post (Height-Adjustable) legs.

A properly installed leg will have a caster or glide that does not extend past the edge of the worksurface.






Attaching Seated Height-Adjustable Legs to a Chevron, Team or Rectangle Worksurface

1. Place worksurface upside down on a clean, scratch resistant surface, such as on a table.

2. Align the marked identification holes on the leg top plate with the pilot holes as shown. Install #10 x 1" wood screws into the three (3) pilot hole locations (2a).








NOTE: There are separate pilot holes for Post (Height-Adjustable) legs AND Access (Fixed Height) legs. Post legs should only be installed using the outward most pilot holes (2a). **DO NOT** install Post legs using the pilot holes for Access legs.






Attaching Standing Height-Adjustable Legs to a Chevron, Team or Rectangle Worksurface

1. Place worksurface upside down on a clean, scratch resistant surface, such as on a table.






Optional Modesty Panel

4. Align the holes on the modesty panel with the pilot holes as shown. Install #10 x 1" wood screws into the two (2) pilot hole locations (4a). Install wood screws in the remaining hole locations on the modesty panel (4b).

5. Align the middle hole on the side hook and side dock with the pilot hole as shown. Install #10 x 1" wood screws into the pilot hole locations (5a). Install two (2) wood screws in the remaining hole locations on the side hook and side dock (5b).

- **6.** Use two (2) or more people (depending on the size and weight) to lift table and place upright.
- **7.** Squeeze snap features together (7a) and insert the center dock into the hole in the worksurface (7b). Repeat if there is more than one (1) center dock.
