

## **CHAPTER 12**

### **GAME ROOMS**

#### **12.01 LICENSES REQUIRED**

No person shall keep or operate upon any premises which is not licensed to sell intoxicating beverages or the holder of a Class "B" Liquor or Fermented Malt Beverage License in the Village open to the public any billiard table or pool table or game room containing amusement and recreational devices including but not limited to the following: pinball machines, coin operated games of skill and all other similar instrumentalities and devices, without first having obtained a license therefor.

#### **12.02 APPLICATIONS**

No license shall be granted except upon written application filed with the Village Clerk and payment unto the Village treasury at the time of such application for a fee of \$100.00 for each such premises to be licensed. All licenses shall expire annually. No license shall be issued to an applicant who is not of good moral character, who is under 18 years of age and who has not resided in the State of Wisconsin continuously for a period of one year prior to such application. The applicant shall also name an agent or agents who are to be in charge of the premises in the absence of the applicant. The same qualifications shall apply to agent or agents of the applicant as apply to the applicant. All applications shall be submitted to the Village Board for approval.

#### **12.03 CLOSING HOURS**

Every licensed game room shall be closed each day between 12:00 A.M. and 8:00 A.M. No one under the age of 18 years shall be permitted upon the premises so licensed unless accompanied by a parent or guardian or unless a parent or guardian has given written permission to be on the premises. Such written permission shall be kept on file by the licensee and shall be shown to a police officer upon request. No game room shall be open for business unless the licensee or approved agent is on the premises.
