

CHAPTER 2

VEHICULAR TRAFFIC AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES/CAMPERS

2.01 STATE TRAFFIC LAWS ADOPTED

Except as otherwise specifically provided in this Ordinance, the statutory provisions in Chapters 340 to 348 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and additionally 218.01(2)(a) change in place of business to be reported, 218.20 to 218.23, motor vehicle salvage dealers and 218.30 through 218.33, motor vehicle auction dealers, of the Wisconsin Statutes, describing and defining regulations with respect to vehicles and traffic, exclusive of any therein relating to penalties to be imposed and exclusive of any regulations for which the statutory penalty is a fine or term of imprisonment are hereby adopted and by reference made part of this ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any statute incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this ordinance. Any future amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein, are intended to be made part of this ordinance in order to secure Uniform Statewide Regulation of Traffic on the Highways, Streets and Alleys of the State of Wisconsin as applied to the Village of Stockbridge.

2.02 ADOPTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE CODE, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Chapters 100, 300 and 305 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code, Rules of Department of Transportation, Division of Motor Vehicles, is hereby adopted.

2.03 OTHER LAWS ADOPTED

The following sections of the Wisconsin Statutes are adopted by reference: Section 941.01, Stats., Negligent operation of a vehicle off the highway and Section 947.045, Stats., Drinking in motor vehicles on the highway. The penalty for violations thereof shall be limited to a forfeiture as provided herein.

2.04 UNIFORM OFFENSES

Forfeitures for violations of the provisions of Chapters 340 to 348 and Secs. 941.01 and 947.045, Stats, are adopted by reference herein and shall conform to the forfeitures for violations of the comparable state offense, including any variations or increases for second offenses.

2.05 STIPULATION OF GUILT OR NO CONTEST

Stipulations of guilt or no contest may be made by persons arrested for violations of this ordinance in accordance with Sec. 66.12(1)(b), Stats., whenever the provisions of Sec. 347.27 are inapplicable to such violations. Stipulations shall conform to the form contained on the uniform traffic citation and complaint under Sec. 345.11, Stats., and may be accepted within five days of the date of the alleged violation. Stipulations may be accepted by the Clerk of Court for Calumet County, Chilton, Wisconsin, which processes the Village citations in conjunction with the Calumet County Sheriff's Department.

2.06 DEPOSITS

Any person stipulating guilt or no contest under this ordinance shall make the deposit required under Sec. 345.26, Stats. or if the deposit is not established under such statute, shall deposit a forfeited penalty as provided in the schedule established by this ordinance. Deposits may be brought or mailed to the Clerk of Court as directed by the arresting officer.

2.07 SPEED LIMITS

1. STATE LIMITS. Secs. 346.57, 346.58 and 346.59, Stats., relating to the maximum and minimum speed of vehicles, are adopted by reference as part of this section as if fully set forth herein, except as specified by Chapter 2 hereafter. Therefore, the speed limit on all streets in the Village of Stockbridge shall be 25 miles per hour unless specifically excepted herein.
2. SPEED LIMITS INCREASED. The speed limits are increased as set forth upon the following the streets within the limits designated:
 - a. 55 Miles Per Hour:
 - i. Lakeshore Drive - all of Lakeshore Drive contained within the Village of Stockbridge municipal boundaries.
 - ii. Hickory Hills Road - all of Hickory Hills Road which enters the Village and continues to Military Road (State Highway 55).
 - iii. Sunset Beach Road - two thousand six hundred forty (2,640) feet from Lakeshore Drive westward to posted 25 miles per hour. Zoned area.
3. SPEED LIMITS DECREASED. The speed limits are decreased as set forth upon the following streets within the limits designated:
 - a. 10 miles per hour:

- i. Stockbridge Legion Firemens Park, Stockbridge Fire Station and Stockbridge Community Recreational Park - entrance driveway, parking areas, and all driveway areas within this area.
- ii. The alley between Lake Street and School Street.

2.08 REGULATION REGARDING VENT, SIDE AND REAR WINDOWS, TRANS 300.69 AND 305.32

Trans 300.69 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code describing and defining glass to be used in vents and rear windows is hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this Chapter as though fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by any of the statutes incorporated herein by reference is required or prohibited by this ordinance. This adoption by reference shall also include any subsequent additions, modifications or other changes to the above statutes.

2.09 CONTROLLED INTERSECTIONS - STOP SIGNS

Official stop signs, requiring every vehicle to stop before entering the intersection, shall be installed and maintained at the following locations, controlling traffic approaching such intersections in the following directions:

2.10 PARKING REGULATIONS

1. PARALLEL PARKING. No person shall park any vehicle upon the streets in the Village if such is not parked parallel to the right hand curb not more than twelve (12) inches from the curb, except where appropriate markings on the Village streets have been placed, which indicate a different angle of parking.
2. PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS AND PUBLIC AREAS.
 - a. Parking is prohibited in all locations where curbing are painted yellow. In addition, when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts of streets or public areas described as follows:

South side of School Street beginning one hundred thirty two (132) feet from corner of Military Street and proceeding around corner onto Church Street and continuing one hundred thirty two (132) feet on Church Street.
 - b. Crosswalks. All properly designated crosswalks within the Village of Stockbridge.
 - c. Fire Station Entrance Driveway.
 - d. Fire Station Building. Areas on east, north and west side of Fire Station portion of building.

- e. All grass or lawn area in Legion-Fireman Park.
- f. On all Highway 55 intersections 35 feet back from the radius of the curb and gutter.
- g. No Parking During School Hours on School Days on North Side of School Street entire length of Street.
- h. Church Street - north end - east side. Time regulated prohibitive parking beginning at a point where the curbing begins on the north end of Church Street and continuing approximately two hundred thirty five (235) feet.
- i. Military Street - Stockbridge Public School Area - East side of Military Street from the corner of School Street continuing north to the end of the Stockbridge Public School Property on a timed basis as posted.
- j. Military Street - Stockbridge Public School Area - East side of Military Street from corner of School Street continuing south fifty (50) feet.

3. CLOSED AREA

- a. Stockbridge Harbor Area. There shall be no parking or loitering in the Stockbridge Harbor Area from a point approximately one hundred ninety-seven (197) feet from the north end of West Street during the hours from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. Persons fishing or docking boats shall not be considered loitering. Area shall be signed "Closed Area from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. except boaters and fishermen".
- b. Directional Traffic Flow. Alley - All traffic shall follow in a northerly direction from a point three hundred ninety six (396) feet from the entrance at Lake Street to the alley exit on School Street.

Erection of Official Traffic Signs and Signals. The Village Board and Street Committee is hereby authorized and directed to procure, erect and maintain appropriate standard traffic signs, signals and markings conforming to the rules of the State Department of Transportation giving notice of the provisions of Chapter 22, Village Code of Ordinances. Signs shall be erected in such locations as to give adequate warnings to users of the street, alley or highway in question.

2.11 RECREATIONAL VEHICLES/CAMPERS

- 1. No person shall inhabit a recreational vehicle or camper within the Village of Stockbridge for a period in excess of seven days.

2. The Village of Stockbridge may by specific permit to be obtained through the Clerk/Treasurer's office, extend that period of time within which a recreational vehicle or camper may be inhabited but only on approval of the Village Board for the Village of Stockbridge.

2.12 COMPRESSION BRAKES PROHIBITED

No person shall use motor vehicle brakes within the village limits of the Village of Stockbridge which are in any way activated or operated by the compression of the engine of any such motor vehicle or any unit or part thereof.

2.13 PENALTY

The penalties regarding the Village of Stockbridge Traffic Ordinances contained herein and the State Traffic Statutes, Administrative Code, Department of Transportation Provisions within this ordinance, where applicable, shall be prescribed by the State of Wisconsin Revised Uniform State Traffic Deposit Schedule and Alcohol Beverages, Harassment, Safety, Tobacco, UW rule, Drug Paraphernalia and Rental Unit Energy Efficiency Violations Deposit Schedule and Uniform Misdemeanor Bail Schedule and Trespass to Land Deposit Schedule. Upon conviction of any alcohol related offense for which the Village has expended funds or incurred expense for the withdrawal or testing of blood or urine, the cost of such service to the Village should be added to any forfeiture, court cost and fees imposed by the Court.

Any person convicted of violating portions of this ordinance not related to vehicular traffic and specifically recreational vehicles/campers and returned checks provisions, shall pay a maximum penalty of \$25.00 per day of violation plus costs of prosecution. Each violation and each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.
