

**Village of Stockbridge Sewer Utility**  
**May 7, 2019**

Chairperson Amy Zahringer called the meeting to order. Commissioners present were Ty Bodden, Robert Ecker, Tim Lemke, and Tammy Mackai. Also present were Zach Propson of MCO and Utility Clerk, Cindy Strebe.

**A. AGENDA / MINUTES APPROVAL:**

**B. TREASURER'S REPORT**

- Total collections for the month were \$14,860.62. This was dispersed into Bond - \$3,700.00, Depreciation - \$743.03, and Operations - \$10,417.59.
- The Operation Account shows a withdrawal of \$10,749.68.
- The Money Market Account accrued \$17.32 in interest.

**C. PUBLIC COMMENT**

**D. OPERATION UPDATE**

- On May 2, 2019 the lines running between the clarifier and aeration basins were blocked causing a Sanitary Sewer Overflow (SSO). Speedy Clean was called to jet the lines. Speedy Clean had to jet it four times due to a sever build-up of rags. Propson also stated that the clarifier skimmer had stopped spinning due to two blown fuses. Rob Frank of MCO came and fixed the fuse/skimmer arm issue. The SSO paperwork was submitted to David Gerdman with the Wisconsin DNR. Strebe contacted the Post Crescent to publish the notice of SSO, which ran on 5/4/2019. Propson will contact Lee's Fabrication again to get a cost of making pre-screens for the plant.
- Propson reported that sludge was hauled to the fields. There was a discussion on process of sludge and where we deposit it.
- MCO and Clerk Strebe are currently working on completing the Wisconsin DNR Compliance Maintenance Annual Report (CMOM). The Resolution 2019-01 will need to be signed at the June 12<sup>th</sup> meeting.

**E. WPDES PERMIT / PHOSPHOROUS REQUIREMENTS**

- Chad Olson of McMahon will be at the June 12, 2019 to outline the project and discuss the Compliance Report that has to be submitted to the DNR by June 30<sup>th</sup>.

**F. INFLOW / INFILTRATION CONCERNS**

- Speedy Clean came last week to clean the sanitary sewer lines located in the orange section of the Village of Stockbridge Sanitary Mapping. This was clean only, we did not televise due to low flow numbers at the plant.
- The infiltration dishes were ordered and delivered today. The price increase \$5.00 each (original quote was \$41.00 each) because Propson decided to order ones that had a gasket attached to them. Total cost is \$690.00.
