


This chart plots the monthly residential MLS® sales for the current and previous year. The light grey line shows the 5 year average residential sales trend.






This chart plots the monthly condominium MLS® sales for the current and previous year. The light grey line shows the 5 year average condominium sales trend.




This chart plots the average monthly MLS® residential sale price for the current and previous year. The light grey line shows the 5 year average residential sale price trend.


Ottawa Condominium Sale Price



This chart plots the average monthly MLS® condominium sale price for the current and previous year. The light grey line shows the 5 year average condominium sale price trend.





Ottawa Residential Listing Inventory




This chart plots the monthly residential MLS® listing inventory (at the end of the month) for the current and previous year. The light grey line shows the 5 year average residential inventory trend.

Ottawa Condominium Listing Inventory




This chart plots the monthly condominium MLS® listing inventory (at the end of the month) for the current and previous year. The light grey line shows the 5 year average condominium inventory trend.


Ottawa Residential Listings Taken





This chart plots the monthly new MLS® condominium listings for the current and previous year. The light grey line shows the 5 year average new condominium listings trend.


Ottawa Inventory Absorption Rate





This chart plots the monthly MLS® absorption rate for two years. The absorption rate is the number of months it would take to sell off existing listing inventory at the current pace of sales. The grey line shows the residential absorption rate and the red line shows the rate for condominiums.






This chart plots the monthly MLS® sales to listing inventory ratio for three years. This ratio indicates the market balance. A ratio between 15%-25% is a balanced market which favours neither buyer or seller. A ratio below 15% favors buyers and a ratio above 25% favors sellers. The grey line shows the residential ratio and the red line shows the ratio for condominiums.



Ottawa Unit Sales




This chart plots the monthly MLS® sales for two years. The red bar represents the condominium portion of total sales and the grey bar the residential portion of total sales.

Ottawa Average Sale Price








This chart plots the monthly active MLS® listings inventory for three years. The red bar shows the condominium portion of total listing inventory and the grey bar is the residential portion.
