### OVERVIEW

The Whistler Museum focuses on preserving and interpreting history, nature and mountain culture. The Nature Walking Tour follows in the footsteps of the Museum's successful Heritage Walking Tour. Both tours are by donation, one hour in length, and are designed to spark the audience's interest in something that they can continue exploring when their tour is done.

The Nature Tour follows the nature trail that starts at the PassivHaus and passes through floodplain and forest upland ecosystems. The tour ends the first time the trail meets Lost Lake Loop. The guide can walk with people back to the PassivHaus along the main trail or direct people on to Lost Lake.

There will be training that follows nature interpretation best practices. You learn about Whistler's amazing natural history and how to communicate in a way that helps audiences connect intellectually and emotionally with nature.
