- Class fees
  - A fee of \$30 will be charged for each Scout attending MBU
  - Additional MB Fees may apply
  - This is a **no refund event.**
- Switching Classes.
  - You are in control of the class you sign up for.
  - You may switch classes and change your schedule prior to MBU.
  - WARNING: If additional fees are paid for a class and you switch classes there is **no refund** for the additional fee.
  - No schedule changes will be performed at the event
  - No Scouts will be able to register at event
- Refund Exceptions
  - Valid Medical Emergency
  - Military / Emergency Personnel Assignment
  - For an exception, a request may be submitted within 1 week after the event and a doctor's note or appropriate documentation will be required for a refund.

- Class Availability
  - You may check for availability by looking at Program Tab
  - Please check availability of classes before signing up.
  - **DO NOT PAY** unless you are satisfied that you can sign up for classes your scout desires. Have backup classes as alternatives just in case.

  - Online Payment can be done by Credit Card, Debit, or Electronic Check.
- Technical Difficulties

- o If you attempt to join after 30 minutes you will not be allowed into the class
- Please be prompt on attending your merit badges
- Zoom Meetings
  - Scouts should join the Zoom meetings 30 minutes prior to class.
  - Each Zoom meeting will conduct multiple breakout rooms for each merit badge
  - A Room Host will be placing each scout into the appropriate class.
  - Each scout will need to modify their Zoom name so as to indicate which merit badge class they are attending.
  - For Example
    - Scout Name John Smith
    - Scout Schedule
      - 8:00 Collections A1 (Session)
      - 10:00 Citizenship in the Community B2 (session)
      - 12:30 Oceanography A3-4 (session)
    - Upon entering each Zoom meeting the scout should change his name
      - John Smith Collections A1
      - John Smith Citizenship in the Community B2
      - John Smith Oceanography A3-4
    - This will assist the Room Host in placing the Scout in the correct breakout room
    - Scouts in the wrong room cannot be given credit
- Uniforms
  - All Scouts must wear tan field uniform.
- Scouts
  - Scouts <u>must</u> bring a current merit badge book, pen or pencil and notebook.
- Troop Leaders / Parents Responsibilities
  - Provide Schedules to Scouts
  - Help assist Scout get to the proper Zoom meetings
  - o Remember No Schedule Changes at event
  - Remind Scouts to donation 5 cans of food for a community organization.





- Scout Schedules
  - MBU will not provide schedules at the event.
