How Do I Register?

- Register online on the Buckeye Council website at: www.buckeyecouncil.org/. Select the  symbol bottom left of the Home page
- To hold a spot on the course, a deposit of \$50 is required at registration.
- The course fee is \$250 before April 1, 2023. After March 31, 2023, the fee increases to \$275. There is a \$50 discount available for participants that pay in full by April 1, 2023. A \$25 discount is available for participants that pay in full by May 31, 2023.
- Fee includes all meals and training materials and one t-shirt. Additional t-shirts available for purchase so you have one for each day on course. The t-shirts will be worn through out the first and second weekends.

What To Bring:

- A full equipment list will be provided, by email prior to the course.
