What to bring -

- (Wear) Weather appropriate clothes
- (Wear) Sturdy closed toe shoes
- Sack lunch (coolers provided)
- Refillable water bottle
- Hat/ sunglasses
- Whistle
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen
- Towel
- Swimsuit
- Favorite fishing pole (we have loaners also)
- Thursday all dens will be doing a bicycle activity so 'bring em if ya got em'. Make sure you bring your protective equipment also.

What not to bring-

- Electronics, we won't have time to play on tablets and phones, and camp is not responsible for lost or damaged items.
- Sandals, they are trip hazards and smashed toes ruin a day
- Knives if under Bear rank this 2024-2025 scout year. Bears and Webelos may bring day 1 to turn in at registration for use at camp.

We will be fishing and swimming daily so don't forget your gear.

Friday will be a shortened day, over after awards. (At approximately 3:00)
