COMPLAINT

1. Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington ("CREW") and Melanie Sloan bring this complaint before the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") seeking an immediate investigation and enforcement action against Robert E. Andrews, the Rob Andrews U.S. House Committee, Loretta Sanchez, the Committee to Re-Elect Loretta Sanchez, Bill Dew, Bill Dew for Congress, William James Breazeale, Breazeale for Congress, Andrew MacPherson and the Barr 2008 Presidential Committee for direct and serious violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act ("FECA").

Complainants

2. Complainant CREW is a non-profit corporation, organized under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. CREW is committed to protecting the right of citizens to be informed about the activities of government officials and to ensuring the integrity of government officials. CREW is dedicated to empowering citizens to have an influential voice in government decisions and in the governmental decision-making process. CREW uses a combination of research, litigation, and advocacy to advance its mission.

- 3. In furtherance of its mission, CREW seeks to expose unethical and illegal conduct of those involved in government. One way CREW does this is by educating citizens regarding the integrity of the electoral process and our system of government. Toward this end, CREW monitors the campaign finance activities of those who run for federal office and publicizes those who violate federal campaign finance laws. Through its website, press releases and other methods of distribution, CREW also files complaints with the FEC when it discovers violations of the FECA. Publicizing campaign finance violators and filing complaints with the FEC serves CREW's mission of keeping the public informed about individuals and entities who violate campaign finance laws and deterring future violations of campaign finance law.
- 4. In order to assess whether an individual, candidate, political committee or other regulated entity is complying with federal campaign finance law, CREW needs the information contained in receipts and disbursements reports that political committees must file pursuant to the FECA, 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2); 11 C.F.R. § 104.1. CREW is hindered in its programmatic activity when an individual, candidate, political committee, or other regulated entity fails to disclose campaign finance information in reports of receipts and disbursements required by the FECA.
- 5. CREW relies on the FEC's proper administration of the FECA's reporting requirements because the FECA-mandated reports of receipts and disbursements are the only source of information CREW can use to determine if a candidate, political committee or other regulated entity is complying with the FECA. The proper administration of the FECA 's reporting requirements includes mandating that all reports

of receipts and disbursements required by the FECA are properly and timely filed with the FEC. CREW is hindered in its programmatic activity when the FEC fails to properly administer the FECA's reporting requirements.

6. Complainant Melanie Sloan is the executive director of Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington, a citizen of the United States and a registered voter and resident of the District of Columbia. As a registered voter, Ms. Sloan is entitled to receive information contained in reports of receipts and disbursements required by the FECA, 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2); 11 C.F.R. § 104.1. Ms. Sloan is harmed when a candidate, political committee or other regulated entity fails to report campaign finance activity as required by the FECA. See FEC v. Akins, 524 U.S. 11, 19 (1998), quoting Buckley v. Valeo, 424 U.S. 1, 66-67 (1976) (political committees must disclose contributors and disbursements to help voters understand who provides which candidates with financial support). Ms. Sloan is further harmed when the FEC fails to properly administer the FECA's reporting requirements, limiting her ability to review campaign finance information.

Respondents

- 7. Robert E. Andrews is the United States Representative for the First Congressional District of New Jersey. The Rob Andrews U.S. House Committee is the principal campaign committee of Robert E. Andrews.
- 8. Loretta Sanchez is the United States Representative for the Forty-Seventh Congressional District of California. The Committee to Re-Elect Loretta Sanchez is the principal campaign committee of Loretta Sanchez.

- 9. Bill Dew is the Republican candidate who sought to represent the Second Congressional District of Utah in the U.S. House of Representatives in the 2008 general election. Bill Dew for Congress is the principal campaign committee of Bill Dew.
- 10. William James Breazeale is the Republican candidate who sought to represent the Seventh Congressional District of North Carolina in the U.S. House of Representatives in the 2008 general election. Breazeale for Congress is the principal campaign committee of William James Breazeale.
- 11. Andrew MacPherson is and/or was a paid campaign staffer for the Barr2008 Presidential Committee during the 2007-2008 election cycle. The Barr 2008Presidential Committee is the principal campaign committee for Bob Barr.

Factual Allegations

- 12. On June 11, 2007, the Rob Andrews U.S. House Committee paid three vendors, Benjamin Peters, Bon ton and Target, a total of \$952.04 for personal clothing for the candidate, Robert E. Andrews. <u>See</u> Rob Andrews U.S. House Committee, Amended 2007 July 15th Quarterly Report, April 12, 2008 (attached as Exhibit A).
- 13. On August 30, 2007, the Committee to Re-Elect Loretta Sanchez paid Lua Dao \$145.12 for clothing for the candidate, Loretta Sanchez. On November 20, 2007, the Committee to Re-Elect Loretta Sanchez paid Loretta Sanchez \$188.97 for "meeting clothing" for the candidate, Loretta Sanchez. See Committee to Re-Elect Loretta Sanchez 2007, January 31st Year-End Report, January 11, 2008 (attached as Exhibit B).
- 14. On August 25, 2008 and September 2, 2008, Bill Dew for Congress paid Mens Wearhouse a total of \$1,089.16 for "campaign clothing for [the] candidate," Bill

Dew. <u>See</u> Bill Dew for Congress 2008, October 15th Quarterly Report, October 15, 2008 (attached as Exhibit C).

- 15. On October 4, 2007, Breazeale for Congress paid Fishers Mens Store \$1,000.00 for "clothes for campaign events" for the candidate, William James Breazeale.

 See Breazeale for Congress, Amended 2007 January 31st Year-End Report, April 25, 2008 (attached as Exhibit D).
- 16. On August 12, 2008, the Barr 2008 Presidential Committee paid Andrew MacPherson \$500.00 for a "clothing allowance." See Barr 2008 Presidential Committee 2008, September Monthly Report, September 19, 2008 (attached as Exhibit E).

COUNT I

17. The FECA specifically prohibits a candidate for federal office from using campaign funds to purchase personal clothing for the candidate or any other person. The Act states that "a contribution or donation . . . shall not be converted by any person to personal use." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(1). The Act further specifies that "a contribution or donation shall be considered to be converted to personal use if the contribution or amount is used to fulfill any commitment, obligation, or expense of a person that would exist irrespective of the candidate's election campaign or individual's duties as a holder of Federal office, including . . . a clothing purchase." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(2)(B). FEC regulations implementing the prohibition on converting campaign funds to personal use make it clear that the prohibition applies to purchases of business or professional clothing for the candidate. The regulations specify that the personal use prohibition applies to "Clothing, other than items of de minimis value that are used in the campaign, such as campaign 'T-shirts' or caps with campaign slogans." 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).

18. By paying vendors a total of \$952.04 for personal clothing for the candidate, Robert E. Andrews, the Rob Andrews U.S. House Committee and Robert E. Andrews violated 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).

COUNT II

- campaign funds to purchase personal clothing for the candidate or any other person. The Act states that "a contribution or donation . . . shall not be converted by any person to personal use." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(1). The Act further specifies that "a contribution or donation shall be considered to be converted to personal use if the contribution or amount is used to fulfill any commitment, obligation, or expense of a person that would exist irrespective of the candidate's election campaign or individual's duties as a holder of Federal office, including . . . a clothing purchase." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(2)(B). FEC regulations implementing the prohibition on converting campaign funds to personal use make it clear that the prohibition applies to purchases of business or professional clothing for the candidate. The regulations specify that the personal use prohibition applies to "Clothing, other than items of de minimis value that are used in the campaign, such as campaign 'T-shirts' or caps with campaign slogans." 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).
- 20. By paying a total of \$334.09 for personal clothing for the candidate, Loretta Sanchez, the Committee to Re-Elect Loretta Sanchez and Loretta Sanchez violated 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).

COUNT III

- 21. FECA specifically prohibits a candidate for federal office from using campaign funds to purchase personal clothing for the candidate or any other person. The Act states that "a contribution or donation . . . shall not be converted by any person to personal use." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(1). The Act further specifies that "a contribution or donation shall be considered to be converted to personal use if the contribution or amount is used to fulfill any commitment, obligation, or expense of a person that would exist irrespective of the candidate's election campaign or individual's duties as a holder of Federal office, including . . . a clothing purchase." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(2)(B). FEC regulations implementing the prohibition on converting campaign funds to personal use make it clear that the prohibition applies to purchases of business or professional clothing for the candidate. The regulations specify that the personal use prohibition applies to "Clothing, other than items of de minimis value that are used in the campaign, such as campaign "T-shirts' or caps with campaign slogans." 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).
- 22. By paying a total of \$1,089.16 for personal clothing for the candidate, Bill Dew, Bill Dew for Congress and Bill Dew violated 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).

COUNT IV

23. FECA specifically prohibits a candidate for federal office from using campaign funds to purchase personal clothing for the candidate or any other person. The Act states that "a contribution or donation . . . shall not be converted by any person to personal use." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(1). The Act further specifies that "a contribution or

donation shall be considered to be converted to personal use if the contribution or amount is used to fulfill any commitment, obligation, or expense of a person that would exist irrespective of the candidate's election campaign or individual's duties as a holder of Federal office, including . . . a clothing purchase." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(2)(B). FEC regulations implementing the prohibition on converting campaign funds to personal use make it clear that the prohibition applies to purchases of business or professional clothing for the candidate. The regulations specify that the personal use prohibition applies to "Clothing, other than items of de minimis value that are used in the campaign, such as campaign 'T-shirts' or caps with campaign slogans." 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).

24. By paying a total of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for personal clothing for the candidate, William James Breazeale, Breazeale for Congress, and William James Breazeale violated 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).

COUNT V

25. FECA specifically prohibits a candidate for federal office from using campaign funds to purchase personal clothing for the candidate or any other person. The Act states that "a contribution or donation . . . shall not be converted by any person to personal use." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(1). The Act further specifies that "a contribution or donation shall be considered to be converted to personal use if the contribution or amount is used to fulfill any commitment, obligation, or expense of a person that would exist irrespective of the candidate's election campaign or individual's duties as a holder of Federal office, including . . . a clothing purchase." 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b)(2)(B). FEC regulations implementing the prohibition on converting campaign funds to personal use make it clear that the prohibition applies to purchases of business or professional

clothing. The regulations specify that the personal use prohibition applies to "Clothing, other than items of de minimis value that are used in the campaign, such as campaign 'Tshirts' or caps with campaign slogans." 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).

26. By paying a total of \$500.00 to Andrew MacPherson for a clothing allowance, the Barr 2008 Presidential Committee and Andrew MacPherson violated 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b) and 11 C.F.R. § 113.1(g)(1)(i)(C).

CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, Citizens for Responsibility and Ethics in Washington and Melanie Sloan request that the Federal Election Commission conduct an investigation into these allegations, declare the respondents to have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act and applicable FEC regulations, and impose sanctions appropriate to these violations and take such further action as may be appropriate.
