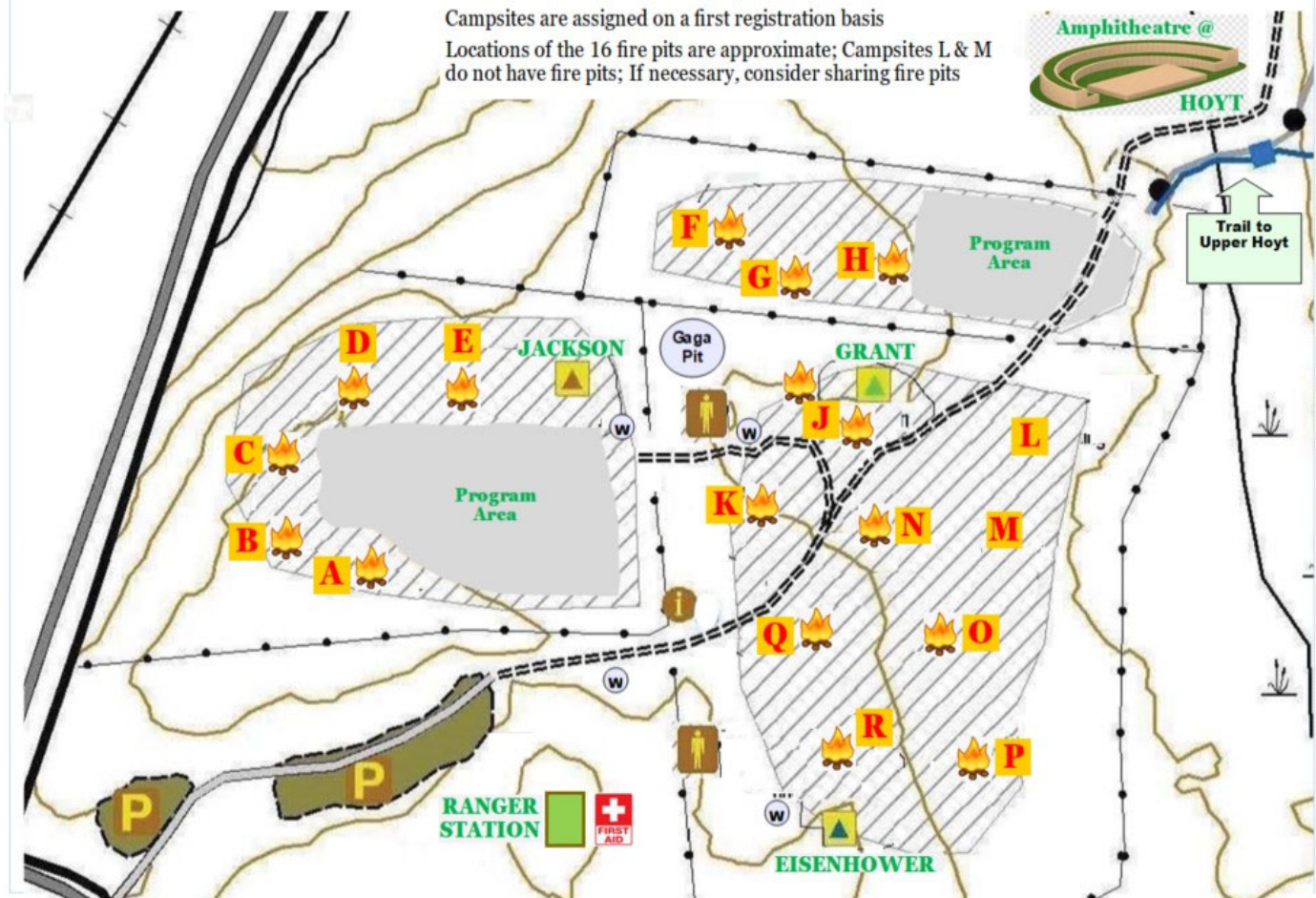
## Saugatuck Camporee Map (Lower Hoyt)
