Scout Day at Lime Rock promises to be a fun and exciting event.

During your stay, please observe the following rules:

Everyone must have their tickets and wavier to enter the gate.

Campers may begin arriving after 6:00 PM Friday evening, September 26. **Please do not arrive before 6 PM.** Enter through the Main (Infield) entrance and present tickets and completed, consent/waiver forms for all occupants of your vehicle. (Note: Waivers for minors attending without their parents, must be notarized.) For adults, attached is the QR code for the daily SpeedWaiver, to be signed the **night before or day of the event**. All adult participants are asked to “**fill out the day of your program, before your arrival.**” You can also click this link to access the waiver:

After you cross the bridge, the Scout pavilion is on the right. If your unit representative has marked your camping area on the map, a committee member will be able to assist you in finding your group. Please let us know where your unit has set up camp. It gets dark early and can be difficult to locate your group in the camping area after nightfall. Use of cell phones is recommended although cell service can be weak in the park. Cars should be parked in the parking lot after equipment is off-loaded.

If arriving Friday evening, you may eat before arrival, bring your dinner with you, or go to <https://limerock.com/know-the-area/local-dining/> for a list of area restaurants.

Ground fires are not permitted. Raised fire pits and stoves/grills on stands may be used. Food concessions are available to purchase meals on Saturday (Grill is open until 3 pm, cold items available until 4:30 pm).

If you want to leave and come back make sure you have picked up and are wearing your Scout Day at Lime Rock wristband. Please be sure to show your bracelet at the gate upon re-entering the park.

Wristband and patch pick up will occur on Friday night, 8-10 pm at the Scout pavilion or 9-Noon on Saturday. You may pick up your unit's/family's patches and wristbands at this time.

Campers must remain in the campground until 7:30 a.m. Saturday morning. This means no one is allowed in the paddock areas or any of the buildings on the property. Failure to observe this rule could result in your dismissal from the park.

For your safety, take a "buddy" along whenever you leave your tenting area.

All bike riders, both youth and adults, must wear helmets when riding and only ride in the camping area. Bikes are not allowed in the paddock or on the race track.

Please adhere to the Scouting America policy on alcohol consumption: Scouting activities are not a place to possess or consume alcoholic beverages. GUIDE TO SAFE SCOUTING.

An adult leader or parent must accompany anyone under the age of 18 wishing to enter the paddock (pit) area. (Groups of Scouts may enter as long as there are two or more leaders present.) Please visit the paddock area after the races begin, not before. **No one is allowed to touch or climb in/on cars unless the driver/owner is present and gives express permission.**

If you are arriving on Saturday morning, please park as instructed by the park security personnel and proceed to the infield spectator area. You must have your tickets and waivers in your possession. Connecticut Yankee Council Scout Day at Lime Rock tickets are not available at the gate. Gates open at 7:30 AM Saturday morning. The last race ends at 4:00 PM. You should plan to be off property by 5:00 PM.

Frequently asked questions:

What should I bring? Lime Rock is a unique motor sport venue in that all spectating is done from a grassy landscape viewing area shaded by trees. For most comfort, blankets and lawn chairs are a must. You may also want to bring along insect repellent, suntan lotion and rain gear, just in case. You may bring a cooler but no glass containers are permitted.

May we bring/ride bikes? Yes, but youth and adults must wear a helmet at all times while riding and bike riding is restricted to the camping area only.

Can I purchase food there? Absolutely, the Paddock A concession stand will be open on Saturday from 7:30 am to approximately 4:30 pm.

May I BBQ? Yes, but only in the camping area and cooking must be done on a camp stove or bring your grill or hibachi. No ground fires please.

Can I bring my dog? No. Dogs are not allowed on the Lime Rock Park property during track events.

What if it rains? All road-racing events run rain or shine. No refunds.

What about those Hot Laps? When available, Hot Laps will be awarded at the crackerbarrel along with information on when and where to assemble. Hot Lap participants must be 21 years or older and registered adult BSA members.

How do I get there?

From New Haven: Take Rt. 34W to Rt. 8N to Torrington. Take Rt. 4W to Cornwall Bridge. Take Rt. 7N to Rt. 112 W. Go past Outfield Entrance for 6/10ths of a mile to the Main Entrance on left, located on White Hollow Road.

From Danbury: Take 84E to exit 7 (US-7N/US-202 Brookfield/New Milford). Continue on 7N for 30 mi. to Rt. 112 W. Go past Outfield Entrance for 6/10ths of a mile to the Main Entrance on left, located on White Hollow Road.

From the West: Take Rt. 84E to Route 22 North to Millerton. Take Rt. 44 East to Route 112 East. Main Entrance is on right, located on White Hollow Road.

The Main Gate entrance is at 60 White Hollow Rd, Lakeville, CT 06039. Directions are available on the Lime Rock website.
