The Klondike is being organized as a day event for Saturday and will take place at the lower part of Hoyt. Camping one or two nights is optional and under troop leadership. Opening ceremony will be at the field in front of the Jackson Pavilion Saturday morning at 9:30 AM. The Klondike will officially end with a closing and awards ceremony at 4:30 pm on Saturday. Troops camping Saturday night will provide their own evening program.

Klondike Derby will start with optional camping Friday night with Troops being able to set up any time after 4 PM. Troops arriving Saturday, should be prepared for opening ceremonies by 9:30 AM.

Troops can camp one night, two nights or just come for the day. Exciting events are being organized by Troop 11, offering patrol competition stations. Troop 11 is requesting troops to sponsor one of the stations.

Troop's Responsibilities:

- To make sure their Scouts are prepared for cold weather activities and/or camping for one to two nights.
- If we move forward with a district activity under potential travel advisory conditions, Unit Leadership is responsible to determine safe driving conditions for their unit and if their Scouts are prepared to meet the challenges of the pending weather. If a Troop has any concerns, please stay home and be safe.
- Troops should carry Part A and B of the Annual Health and Medical Form and a permission form for each scout signed by a parent or legal guardian.
- Troops camping should have one adult certified in First Aid/CPR.


